

NOTICE OF CLOSED ATTORNEY-CLIENT SESSION

The purpose of the closed attorney-client session is to discuss litigation strategy and settlement negotiations related to litigation styled PPI Inc. v. Florida Gaming Control Commission, FGCC Case Nos. 2024-031374 and 2024-057184.
