

NOTICE OF CLOSED ATTORNEY-CLIENT SESSION

The purpose of the closed attorney-client session is to discuss litigation strategy and settlement negotiations related to litigation styled Florida Gaming Control Commission v. Stephen Glen Kirby, case no. 2024-015793.
