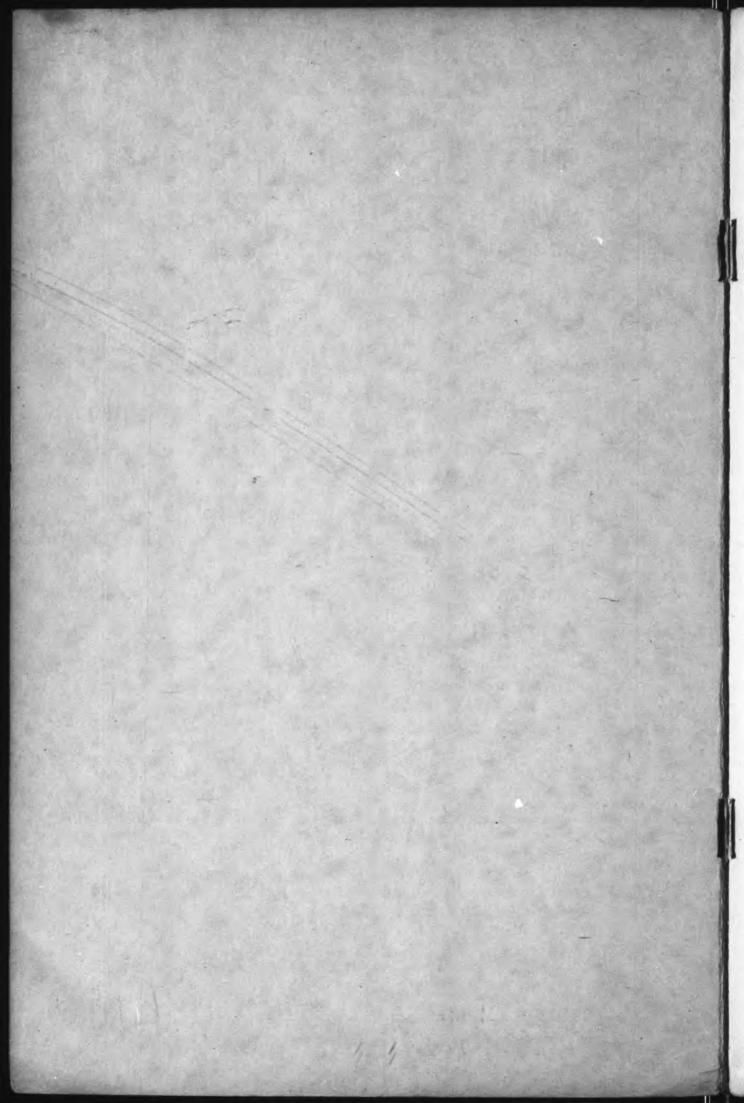

T. G. Futch served as Attorney for the Commission throughout the entire year at a salary of \$3,000 per year, as provided by the Racing Act as amended by the 1935 Legislature.
