

The Florida State Racing Commission respectfully submits herewith its Eleventh Annual Report for the period, July 1, 1941, to June 30, 1942, inclusive.

DAYTONA BEACH JOCKEY CLUB filed on July 1, 1941, application for permit to conduct horse racing in Volusia County. Permit was denied by the Commission July 3, 1941.

Daytona Beach Jockey Club filed amended application for permit to conduct horse racing on August 15, 1941. Application as amended was denied by Commission on August 15, 1941.

FLORIDA FRONTON ASSOCIATION filed on July 1, 1941, application for permit to conduct exhibitions of the Spanish ball game called Jai-Alai at Miami Beach. Action on application was deferred by Commission.

Florida Fronton Association filed amended application for permit under Florida Jai-Alai Association on August 14, 1941. Application as amended was denied by Commission on August 14, 1941.

PAN-AMERICAN EXHIBITION COMPANY filed on July 1, 1941, application for permit to conduct exhibitions of the Spanish ball game called Jai-Alai in Hillsborough County. Action on application was deferred by Commission.

Pan-American Exhibition Company withdrew its application for permit on August 14, 1941.

THE SARASOTA KENNEL CLUB requested racing dates by letter, but did not file proper application, on July 2, 1941. Commission deferred setting dates for the Sarasota Kennel Club until proper application had been filed:

The Sarasota Kennel Club filed application for dates on August 15, 1941. The Commission withheld racing dates until said Sarasota Kennel Club could show the Commission that it possessed the same qualifications for racing that it had when its racing permit was granted as required under the Laws of Florida.

HOLLYWOOD JOCKEY CLUB filed on July 2, 1941, application for dates to conduct horse racing at Gulf Stream Park. Action on application was deferred by the Commission on July 3, 1941, and August 15, 1941.

WEST COAST JOCKEY CLUB filed on July 2, 1941, application for permit to conduct horse racing in Hillsborough County. Action was deferred by the Commission until proper amended application is filed with the Racing Commission.

The Commission denied the application for permit of West Coast Jockey Club on August 15, 1941.

All tracks except Sarasota Kennel Club and the Hollywood Jockey Club operated during the 1941-42 racing season.

The campaign against the stimulation of thoroughbreds has continued under the guidance of Dr. J. G. Catlett, Chief Veterinarian, and Dr. Y. T. Oester, Chief Chemist, and staff.

The laboratory of the Florida State Racing Commission was dismantled and placed in storage from April 15, 1941, to November 1, 1942, at which time a new location was secured at 2254 N. W. 28th Street, Miami.

Additional apparatus and facilities were provided to take care of increased number of samples to be tested. The number of samples tested during season 1940-41 was 1,121, and samples tested for season 1941-42 was 2,426, an increase of 116 per cent.

The following is a summary of tests made in the laboratory, and the results of analysis as made by Dr. Oester.

#### COMPARISON

1941-1942 Season 1940-1941

There was a decrease in attendance of 500,384 which resulted in a decrease in the State Attendance Tax of \$92,120.30. There was a decrease in mutuel play of \$4,678,617.00 which resulted in a decrease in the 3% State Tax of \$140,358.51 in revenue to the State. These two decreases can reasonably be attributed to the war.

The 1941 Legislature passed two acts, being Chapter 20,306 and Chapter 20,307, Acts of 1941, which appropriated the breaks and levied an additional 5% tax upon every pari-mutuel pool conducted by horse tracks within the State. As a result of these two acts there was an increase in the total revenue to the State from the mutuel taxes of \$2,050,001.79.

The 1941 Legislature passed an Act, being Chapter 20,890, Laws of Florida, Acts of 1941, which provided for payments to the State General Revenue Fund of 3% from all State funds termed "Special Funds", or other funds, the source of which is not the general revenue fund, or funds which become a part of the general revenue fund of any State department, institution, board, agency, division or commission, which is deposited by or through the office of the Comptroller or the State Treasurer. The State Racing Commission funds were by the terms of said act classified and determined to be "Special Funds" from which the deduction of 3% should be made. As a result of this Act, the total funds collected by the Racing Commission were assessed 3%, which amounted to \$131,785.85, all of which was paid to and became a part of the State General Revenue Fund.

There was an increase in expenditures by the Commission during the past fiscal year of \$7,933.99. This increase was largely due to re-locating the laboratory in new and larger quarters, purchasing additional and necessary equipment, making necessary plumbing and electrical installations at the laboratory, and the employment of additional laboratory personnel.



### CONCLUDING REMARKS OF THE COMMISSION

For the past fiscal year the Commission has made every effort to carry out the program and policy of the present Commission heretofore adopted by it and set forth in its Tenth Annual Report, which program and policy is as follows, to-wit:

- Complete and rigid enforcement of Racing Laws in order to insure the maximum revenue to the State and to the State Old Age Pension Fund.
- 2. Economy in supervision and management, having in view at all times that proper regulation and supervision must be had even though it entails additional expense.
- 3. A vigorous campaign in cooperation with the National Association of Racing to investigate and prosecute all violations of the laws prohibiting the use of stimulants on horses and dogs.
- 4. A complete revision of the Rules and Regulations governing Horse Racing, Dog Racing and Jai-Alai. The Commission decided to make the foregoing revision after an unprecedented and highly successful open forum and discussion with owners and trainers of dogs, operators of Dog Tracks, Track and State officials; all of whom submitted their recommendations and were advised of the proposed changes. These met with the general approval of all parties interested. The Commission, however, plans to reconcile such recommendations to its primary duty of protecting first the interest of the public and thereafter that of the persons directly connected with Racing.
- 5. A continuous campaign for the improvement of the racing premises, grandstand and track facilities, sanitary conditions for jockeys as well as improvement in the handling and care of animals, both horses and dogs, participating in Racing:
- 6. Co-operation with law enforcement authorities in an active campaign to minimize and, if possible, to completely eliminate all forms of illegal wagering both off and at the Tracks which directly or indirectly curtail or reduce the revenue to the State of Florida from Horse Racing, Dog Racing and Jai-Alai.

The Commission wishes to call attention to the following accomplishments during the past year:

(a) The Commission held an investigation of the Gables Racing Association and after a thorough and impartial investigation of all the facts the Commission found that a change in the ownership and control of the Gables Racing Association, and of the personnel of said Association, would best subserve the interests of the State of Florida and the racing industry as a whole. Whereupon the Racing Commission did urge the owners of stock of the Gables Racing Association to cooperate with the Commission in its efforts and endeavor to improve the conditions existing by a disposition by them of their stock in said corporation to any purchasers who might be available and who were persons of financial responsibility, integrity and of good repute, with recognized experience and ability essential to proper and creditable conduct of racing in Florida, and who would further the best interests of the State and racing in this State by a complete re-organization of said corporation. The owners of the stock of the Gables Racing Association did cooperate with the Racing Commission and did dispose of their stock to a group approved by the Commission; and as a result of said investigation a complete re-organization of the Gables Racing Association was brought about whereby there was a complete change in the ownership of said stock and the personnel of said Association, all of which the Commission feels was for the best interests of the State of Florida, and the racing industry as a whole.

- (b) In keeping with said policy and in carrying out said program the Commission has improved its laboratory and enlarged the personnel so as to better detect and prohibit the use of stimulants on horses and dogs.
- (c) The Commission completely revised the rules and regulations governing horse racing and dog racing, which revisions the Commission feels has definitely improved the standard of horse and dog racing in Florida.
- (d) At the suggestion of the Commission many improvements of the racing premises, and in particular improvements pertaining to the sanitary conditions for jockeys, as well as improvements in the handling and care of animals, both horses and dogs, have been made at many of the racing plants by licensees conducting racing in Florida.
- (e) With the cooperation of the law enforcement authorities of the various communities the Commission conducted an active campaign to eliminate all forms of illegal wagering, both off and at the tracks, and the Commission feels that as a result of this campaign there was a material decrease of illegal wagering in Florida during the past year.

In conclusion the Commission wishes to make the following observations: While there was a large decrease in attendance and a decrease of approximately \$4,500,000.00 in mutuel play, which resulted in a decrease in the State Attendance Tax of approximately

\$92,000.00 and a decrease of the 3% State Tax of approximately \$140,000.00, the Commission feels that these decreases were entirely due and can easily be attributed to the war.

The Commission feels that the two Acts of the 1941 Legislature imposing an additional tax of 5% upon the mutuel play at horse racing and appropriating the breakage at the horse tracks to the State proved to be very successful, and increased the total revenue of mutuel taxes to the State slightly over \$2,000,000.00.

The foregoing report is made in compliance with Sub-section 2, Section 2 of Chapter 14,832, Laws of Florida, Acts of 1931, as amended.
