## RACING YEAR AROUND SUBSTANTIAL INDUSTRY

Racing in this State is no longer a seasonal activity, but has grown into a year around industry and Florida today is regarded as the nation's foremost racing center.

The periods of time within which racing is authorized in this State, have, during the past eighteen years, been extended by the Legislature from time to time.

During the period covered by this Report, your Commission supervised the operations of 4 horse tracks, 13 dog tracks, and 1 Jai Alai Fronton. These operators were granted and operated 1404 racing or playing days during the 1948-1949 season. Every available authorized day of racing was consumed and expended by the operators, and during each day of the year there was racing conducted in this State, save and except during the period between November 1 and November 14 when racing is not authorized, and consequently was not conducted.

The records of your Commission reflect that during the period covered by this Report 9611 occupational licenses were issued to persons employed in activities under the jurisdiction of your Racing Commission. Of this number 4808 persons were employed directly by the several operators and of this number 85% were Florida citizens except those exempted by law, who are benefited and protected by the requirement of law that 85% of track employees must be bona fide citizens and residents of Florida, and must be paid a likely percentage of the total payroll. This provision of law has been strictly complied with by the operators and carefully checked by your Commission in order to assure a large number of our citizens a means of livelihood.

In addition to the employment feature of the racing enterprise, the sale of food, feed, medications and other services rendered the thousands of horses and dogs involved, together with the sales and services rendered to the many owners, trainers, jockeys and other persons directly and indirectly connected with the sport while residing in this State during the racing seasons, is in itself a substantial commercial enterprise from which our local citizens benefit and profit. We need not point out that racing is not only one of the major revenue producers for the State, but attracts many visitors who in turn enjoy many of our other winter and summer attractions.

## ATTENDANCE AND PLAY

During the fiscal year covered by this report, Dog and Horse Racing and Jai Alai Exhibitions attracted a total paid attendance of 4,641,038 patrons who wagered \$178,171,736.00. In comparison with the preceding 1947-1948 season which had a total paid attendance of 4,344,479 patrons who wagered \$180,647,561.00, reflects an increase in attendance of 06.83% and a decrease in wagering of 01.37%. It is significant to note that while racing experienced a general increase in attendance and a decrease in wagering, dog racing showed an increase in both wagering and attendance, while horse racing and Jai Alai showed a decrease both in wagering and attendance. The increase in attendance may be said to be due to the increase in the number of racing or playing days, 1404, scheduled during the 1948-1949 season, as compared with 1318 days scheduled during the 1947-1948 season or an increase of 86 days. These additional days were expended by dog tracks while horse tracks operated 10 days less during the 1948-1949 season than the preceding season. The general decrease in wagering at the horse tracks was due to a natural economic trend that was experienced generally in other racing states, and the decrease in this State was slight when compared with the greater decrease in other States.

Attached hereto and hereafter included and made a part of this Report, are detailed figures and statements covering the fiscal year ending June 30, 1949, relating to the receipts and disbursements of your Commission, attendance, pari-mutuel wagering, taxes paid to the State, and the amount distributed to the public by each individual racing association, together with other information relative to the officers and operations of each association.

## STATE INCOME FROM PARI-MUTUEL WAGERING

An examination of the detailed statistical report hereinafter set out in this Report will reveal and disclose that the total revenue to the State for the current fiscal year from pari-mutuel wagering aggregated \$13,222,461.34. The various licensed operators received from pari-mutuel wagering \$17,083,524.06 and there was distributed to the public as awards or dividends from winning pari-mutuel tickets \$148,501,508.80. Of the aggregate amount received by the State only 02.02 percent was expended by this Commission in connection with all its year-around activities in directing, supervising and controlling racing in this State.

Each of the sixty-seven Counties in this State received the sum of \$82,400.00 as their proportionate share from the three percent tax upon pari-mutuel play, admission tax, occupational license and registration fees. This amount is greatly in excess of the \$33,000.00 guaranteed by law to each of the several Counties from the General Revenue Fund.

The Old Age Assistance Fund received the sum of \$7,024,304.53 as its share from the two percent tax plus one-half of the breaks upon pari-mutuel play at dog tracks and Jai Alai Fronton, and the five percent tax plus the breaks upon pari-mutuel play at horse tracks.

## RACING COMMISSION LABORATORY

The Commission has been vigilant in detecting and preventing the stimulation of horses and dogs.

4802 samples of dog and horse urine and horse saliva were collected at the various licensed tracks in this State by the Commission's agents under the supervision of the Commission's Veterinarians and thereafter submitted to the Chief Chemist of the Racing Commission for



analysis for the purpose of determining whether or not the animals from which the samples had been taken had been improperly stimulated or depressed prior to the race.

Only 3 of such samples, 2 horse and 1 dog, were found to be positive for stimulants and each of these cases were properly handled by the Commission. The small number of samples found to contain stimulants is a splendid testimonial of the preventive work and careful supervision of these officials under the direction of this Commission, and further indicates that this highly improper and unlawful method of affecting the results of a race is not used to any great extent in this State.

At the request of horse tracks in Cuba and Nassau, your Commission Laboratory has analyzed approximately 179 samples of horse urine and saliva, from horses competing at these foreign tracks at a charge of \$10.00 per specimen.

### THOROUGHBRED BREEDING IN FLORIDA

The state is fast becoming a breeding ground for thoroughbred race horses. There was a record crop of 36 foals, 18 of the crop were foaled in Marion County, 9 in Dade County, 7 in Broward County and 2 in Duval County. There are 8 thoroughbred nurseries in the state; Rosemere Farm and Jack Horne's Farm in Marion County; Christopher Ranch in Dade County; Golden Shoe Farm; Dr. G. E. Woollard Farm, Martha Bright Farm and Pine Island Ranch in Broward County, and the Keenaland Farm in Duval County.

Some of the Florida thoroughbreds have competed and met with great success at tracks in this State and elsewhere.

Werewolf bred at Ocala, Florida by E. Huebeck, Jr., won the Florida Breeder's \$10,000.00 Stake at Hialeah during the 1948-1949 season, and was sold to Mrs. J. G. Smythe of California for \$14,000.00.

### PERMITS CANCELLED

Your Commission cancelled the following racing permits pursuant to Section 550.06, Florida Statutes, 1941, for failure of the permit holders to construct a track within twelve months after ratification of their permit: Palm Beach Jockey Club, Inc. (Horse) Palm Beach County; Ponce DeLeon Raceway Association (Horse) St. Johns County; Tampa Jai Alai Fronton, Inc. Hillsborough County; Panama City Kennel Club, Inc. (Dog) Bay County. (This latter permit reinstated by Chapter 25256, laws of Florida 1949).

There were no new permits applied for nor granted by the Commission during the current fiscal year.

### LEGISLATION

The regular 1949 session of the Legislature undertook the consideration of proposed bills relating to horse racing, both harness and running, dog racing, and pari-mutuel wagering.

Passed and becoming a law of this State were the following acts:

**Chapter 25016** regulates public utilities in furnishing private wire service for the dissemination of information and prohibits the use of such service for gambling purposes. This act is now being litigated in the Courts. One of its purposes is to prevent the dissemination of racing information to and by "book makers," and by curtailing their illegal gambling activities, protect the revenue derived by the State from racing.

**Chapter 25242** cancels and annuls all racing permits issued prior

to January 1, 1943 where the Permit Holder did not conduct racing within a period of five years prior to June 7, 1949.

**Chapter 25256** extended the time by which race tracks may be constructed by holders of permits for dog racing when the location of such tracks is west of the Apalachicola River. This law had the effect of reinstating the permit of Panama City Kennel Club Inc., heretofore cancelled by your Commission for the reason hereinbefore related.

**Chapter 25257** amended the law relating to the taxes paid to the State by running horse tracks from the total contributions of all pari-mutuel pools. This act affects only one horse track, Sunshine Park Racing Association, and authorizes said track to pay a flat license fee of \$4,000.00 per day when their average daily pari-mutuel play is less than \$175,000.00 in lieu of the required 8% from the total contributions of all pari-mutuel pools that is paid by the other licensed horse tracks which all have more than a \$175,000.00 daily average pari-mutuel play.

**Chapter 25258** authorizes the Racing Commission to grant one additional day of racing during the race meeting period granted to any track, upon the application of the track, and all profits, less actual operating costs by the track, from such additional days operations, shall be paid into a scholarship fund to be administered by the Board of Control in granting scholarships to attend institutions of higher learning of the state. If all the tracks elect and consent to operate the additional day, a generous amount of money will be made available for a most worthy cause—the higher education of our youth.

**Chapter 25267** relates to the vacating and closing of streets and alleys on platted lands occupied by race tracks and for race track automobile parking purpose where the title to the land is vested in ratified permit holders.

**Chapter 25354** authorizes certain qualified bona fide non profit cooperative agricultural associations to race registered "quarter horses" only at a licensed horse track and for not more than six days.

**Chapter 25413** authorizes operating dog tracks located in the State North of Latitude 30 degrees to operate, not in excess of 90 days, at any time during the calendar year. This law affects only Pensacola Kennel Club, Inc., Orange Park Kennel Club, and Jacksonville Kennel Club, Inc., and authorizes such track to split its operating days during the year.

## LITIGATION

During the fiscal year covered by this Report, your Commission, through its Attorney, participated in and was a party litigant in four distinct legal proceedings instituted against your Commission, and on each occasion your Commission resisted each action to the legal appellate limits. Said legal proceedings related to the construction and interpretation of Racing laws and Rules of your Commission.

## CONCLUSION

We the present members of your Commission, wish to express our deep appreciation for the confidence and trust reposed in us in the administration of racing in our State, and we pledge to you and the people of Florida our continued loyalty and best efforts.

To our predecessors, and particularly Honorable Charles F. Baldwin and Honorable William B. Watson, Jr. we sincerely and genuinely thank for their friendly and courteous cooperation and assistance.

As heretofore, and in detail hereafter, shown, no other source of taxation in Florida results in such substantial revenue to the State

with so little imposition on its citizens as racing, as well as attracting many visitors and other persons connected directly with racing to our State to reside and enjoy our many other attractions. For these reasons racing should be fostered in every way legitimately practicable.

Your Commission has been diligent in its supervision of racing and will continue to exercise strict and rigid supervision of every person connected with racing activities. We shall be just and fair in our actions and tenaciously protect the interest of the public and the State. To properly and practicably carry out our functions and duties and promote public confidence, and mutuality of interest in the sport, your present Commissioners have and will continue to individually, and as a group, personally visit each and every racing installation in this State and from time to time personally inspect their activities while operating.

The Florida State Racing Commission is a member of the National Association of State Racing Commissions. Twenty-six states now have a Racing Commission that is a member of this Association. At the annual meeting in New York last May, Leo Edwards, Chairman for the Florida State Racing Commission, was elected Vice-President of the National Association of State Racing Commissioners and B. P. Beville, Secretary, Commissioner Ralph Crum, Commissioner Roy Patience, and Commissioner Percy Corbin were each appointed on important Committees of the Association. At that time the Florida State Racing Commission extended an invitation to the Association to hold their 1951 convention in Miami during the winter racing season. The invitation was unanimously accepted and we now have the assurance that not only each Racing Commission of each state will be represented here but also officials of race tracks throughout the entire world. It is the sincere wish of this Commission that our Honorable Governor will extend Florida's address of welcome upon the opening of this important convention.

The success of our administration of racing has been and will be due largely to the loyalty and diligence of those persons employed by your Commission to carry out its mandates and functions. We would like to take this opportunity of expressing our appreciation to the various employees who have assisted us in the supervision, control and direction of racing during this term and particularly are we grateful to Mr. Robert Kelly, who has ably served as Supervisor of Racing for the past six years; Mrs. Inez Martin who has served most capably and efficiently as Office Secretary for the past five years; Mr. Irving Harrington, Chief Auditor of your Commission; Dr. Elsie Bellows, P. H. D., Chief Chemist in charge of the Commission Laboratory; Dr. E. D. Clawson, Chief Veterinarian, and Charles Nelson, F. G. (Pug) Wilson and Hollis Rinehart, Jr., Stewards at the horse tracks who have each merited the confidence and exhibited the ability and qualifications required by their respective positions.

We sincerely trust that in the future the track operators will continue to cooperate with your Commission and keep racing upon the high plane, and merit the confidence of the public, that it now enjoys.
