



The above permits were filed in June, 1957, and as of this date no action has been taken.

#### ADMINISTRATION

Robert Kelly, Supervisor of Racing for the past fifteen years, and Louis Derteen, Jr., the Assistant Supervisor, direct the various activities of the Racing Commission. Irving Harrington is in charge of the auditing department; Tom C. Parker, the investigating division; and Dr. Elsie S. Bellows supervises the Commission laboratory.

In the Commission office, located at 911 Metropolitan Bank Building, Miami, are kept all the records and statistics of the various racing activities conducted in the State. This report contains but a small fraction of these records and any other data, too voluminous to be included in its entirety, will be gladly furnished upon request.

#### INVESTIGATIVE DIVISION

The Racing Commission, with the interest of the public in mind, maintains an investigative division whose function it is to enforce the racing laws and the Rules and Regulations of Racing as promulgated by the Commission.

With the cooperation of the local and state law enforcement agencies, the track safety departments and the association managements, this division was able to effectively promote and correlate the investigations of all illegal activities on the race tracks of Florida. During the period covered by this report, 306 persons were ejected from Florida race tracks for various reasons.

The Investigative department devotes much of its time to the enforcement of the "85% law" which requires at least 85% of the employees at each track to be bona fide Florida residents and that 85% of the weekly payrolls be paid to them. This law assures Florida citizens a fair proportion of the positions at each track.

This division is responsible for obtaining the fingerprints and photographs of all officers, directors and employees of each track. During the past year some 875 new fingerprints were added to the permanent files maintained in the Miami office.

With the cooperation of the Florida Railroad and Public Utilities Commission, the diagrams of telephone installations at the various tracks were made. The Racing Commission wishes to express its appreciation to Mr. Wilkins Lenhart, the telephone engineer for that agency for his assistance in the enforcement of the "anti-dissemination" law.

In addition the Commission wishes to thank the Federal Bureau of Investigation, and the Safety departments of the various racing associations for their splendid cooperation during the past year,

#### LABORATORY

To keep racing on the highest possible plane, the Racing Commission maintains a complete racing laboratory. Urine and saliva samples taken from winning thoroughbreds and greyhounds are analyzed microchemically at this laboratory. As a result of these analyses, which detect and identify any illegal drug or medicine, fraudulent doping practices in Florida have been decreased considerably. Without this laboratory control, unscrupulous individuals might attempt to administer stimulants which would affect the racing qualities of their animals. The effectiveness of this program is best illustrated by the fact that of the 8,759 samples taken from winners in Florida, only nine, after analysis, were found to contain illegal drugs or medicines. In contrast, 475 samples from various foreign racing boards were analyzed (at a charge of \$10.00 each) and four of these were positive for forbidden drugs.

Dr. Bellows and the laboratory staff are constantly searching for new procedures to identify stimulants and attempting to learn the qualities of each newly marketed drug. Through their conscientious efforts, the Florida State Racing Commission enjoys the reputation of having one of the finest and most efficient racing laboratories in the world.

#### SCOPE OF RACING

During the past racing season the pari-mutuel handle was again the largest in the history of Florida racing. The total play at the twenty-three associations was \$322,948,073.00, or 3.95 per cent more than during 1955-1956. The accumulated attendance during the year was 2.03 per cent more than the previous year as 6,035,932 persons attended the four horse tracks, fifteen greyhound tracks and four jai-alai frontons.

The State derived more revenue from racing during the past fiscal year than ever before. The increase was 3.26 per cent, as the various taxes and license fees amounted to \$24,969,496.52.

The 67 counties of the State each received \$175,000.00, of which \$138,000.00 was apportioned under the old racing laws and \$37,000.00 from the additional taxes on greyhound tracks enacted by the 1955 Legislature. This sum is \$10,000.00 more than each county received during 1955-1956.

The Old Age Assistance Fund also experienced an increase. The \$12,368,479.78 received was \$32,161.94 more than was received during the previous year.

Although the sum of \$24,969,496.52 was collected by the Commission during the season in review, only 1.79 per cent was expended in controlling, directing and supervising the operations and activities of the various licensees. The expenditures for the year represent a saving of \$28,512.21 from the budget appropriation.

#### ABANDONED PARI-MUTUEL TICKETS

Pursuant to Chapter 29688, Acts of 1955, the Legislature authorized that all abandoned pari-mutuel tickets issued after November 15, 1955, should escheat to the State two years after the date of issue. Although the various racing associations are not required to make their first remittances until July 1, 1958, deposits of \$3,992.20, representing the unclaimed tickets at Jacksonville Kennel Club and Orange Park Kennel Club during the 1955-1956 season, have been made to the account of the State school fund and will be used for the support and maintenance of free public schools as provided by law.

#### SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Pursuant to Chapter 25258, Acts of 1949, the Legislature authorized the various tracks and frontons to operate a total of twenty-two additional days of racing during the past year for the purpose of creating and providing State Scholarships from the profits derived therefrom. A total of \$349,514.06 was remitted to the State Board of Control for Institutions of Higher Learning.

In addition, the Commission in compliance with Chapter 28499, Acts of 1953, authorized the applicable tracks and frontons in Hillsborough County to operate a total of three additional days for the benefit of the University of Tampa, from which that institution realized the sum of \$13,767.94 to be used for scholarships for worthy students.

#### CHARITY DAYS

In conformance with Chapter 20843, Acts of 1941, the operators of the various tracks and frontons are permitted to apply for an additional day wherein the net proceeds are to be contributed to charities of their choice, subject to provision designating the University of Miami as a charitable institution entitled to a minimum of 25 per cent of the day's profits. Permission was granted by the Commission for the operation of fifteen such days during the year as a result of which \$320,442.06 was realized by the University of Miami.

#### LEGISLATION

During the 1957 session of the Legislature, the Florida Statutes were amended to include the following provisions:

(1) The Racing Commission now has the power to subpoena and the power to levy fines for infractions of the Statutes or Commission Rules.

- (2) The winter greyhound racing season now commences November 1 of each year instead of November 15.
- (3) The immediate transmission by radio or television of "stake races", if they are broadcast or televised nationally, may be allowed in addition to the two feature races previously allowed per week.
- (4) The Statutes now require that an election for the ratification of a racing permit shall be a special election.
- (5) Any person having been ejected from a Florida race track who returns to a track without having been re-instated by the Commission now is guilty of a misdemeanor and can be punished by law.
- (6) The provisions for a charity day have been broadened to include charitable institutions within 100 miles of a race track holding that day for charity.

#### LITIGATION

During the year in review, the Racing Commission was a party to the following suits:

Brevard Kennel Club, Inc. v. Florida State Racing Commission.

State, Ex Rel., Indian River Kennel Club, Inc. v. State Racing Commission, Et Al.

State, Ex. Rel., Martin County Kennel Club, Inc. v. C. H. Ratliff, as Chairman of Florida State Racing Commission, Et Al.

This litigation arose as a result of three applicants applying for permits to operate summer dog racing establishments, which applications were denied by the State Racing Commission because the requested summer permits were not for locations in the territory lying wholly east of the St. Johns River and south of the Matanzas Inlet, as provided by statute. The applicants filed mandamus in the Supreme Court of Florida seeking to force the Commission to grant said applicants racing permits. The Supreme Court on December 5, 1956, sustained the construction of the statute by the State Racing Commission and granted the Commission's motion to dismiss the alternative writs theretofore issued by the Supreme Court.

Tropical Park, Inc., and Maurice J. Hirsbstein v. C. H. Ratliff, Et Al.

This is a case in which the petitioners sought certiorari in the Supreme Court of Florida from an order of the State Racing Commission entered on April 4, 1957, revoking the license of Tropical Park, Inc., and denying Maurice J. Hirshstein of attending any pari-mutuel operation in the State of Florida for violation of the Florida Statutes and Rules and Regulations of the Commission. This case is pending before the Supreme Court of Florida and has not been decided at the writing of this report.

State, Ex Rel., Caron, Inc. v. Florida State Racing Commission.

This is an original proceeding in the Supreme Court of Florida seeking to force the Commission to issue to Caron, Inc., a permit for operation of a jai-alai fronton in Duval County. An application had been previously made and presented to the Commission and the Commission had denied the appli-

cation on numerous grounds set forth in its order showing that the applicant had not complied with the statute. A motion to dismiss the petition for alternative writ of mandamus has been filed in this case and the matter is still pending in the Supreme Court of Florida.

Leon V. McLaulin and Sanford-Orlando Kennel Club, Inc., v. Seminole Park and Fairgrounds, Inc. and Florida State Racing Commission.

This was an action in the Second Judicial Circuit, Leon County, for a declaratory decree seeking to void a harness horse racing permit issued by the State Racing Commission in Seminole County, Florida. The State Racing Commission had previously ruled that Section 550.05, Florida Statutes, relating to distances between racing establishments meant that the 100-mile provision referred to dog track v. dog track and horse track v. horse track, but that it did not mean that a harness horse track could not be established within a radius of 100 miles of a dog track. Judge Hugh Taylor of the Second Judicial Circuit, Leon County, held on May 30, 1957, that the 100-mile provision specified in Section 550.05, Florida Statutes, prohibited the issuance of a racing permit to the harness horse track in Seminole County. At this time no appeal from said decision has been taken.

State of Florida, Ex Rel., Emanuel S. Kramer v. Florida State Racing Commission, Et Al.

This is a petition for writ of mandamus and petitioner seeks to compel the State Racing Commission to make available to him for inspection all annual audits of all greyhound racing tracks, applications for permits filed by all greyhound racing tracks, daily and weekly reports of employees filed by the Broward County Kennel Club, Inc., and any other information and reports in the possession of the State Racing Commission that may be pertinent to a suit which he has instituted against the Broward County Kennel Club, Inc., and its officers and directors upon the theory that such records are public documents and as such petitioner as a citizen is entitled to inspect the same. A motion to quash the alternative writ has been filed and as of the date of the writing of this report the matter is still pending in the Circuit Court of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit, Dade County.

#### NATIONAL CO-ORDINATION

Members of this Commission are members of the National Association of State Racing Commissioners. Through a policy of reciprocity, the Racing Commissions of the various states having legalized pari-mutuel activities work together in the interest of better racing. A ruling made by the Commission of any member state is enforced by the other commissions. In addition, all Racing Commissions benefit from the exchange of valuable information and new ideas.

The National Association held their 1957 convention in Los Angeles, California, where Florida was represented by Secretary John R. Ring and Commissioner W. H. Toole, Jr. The Association of Official Racing Chemists met in conjunction with this convention and Dr. Elsie S. Bellows attended.

At the convention, Secretary Ring was elected First Vice-President of the National Association and Dr. Bellows was elected to the executive board of the Chemists.

#### FLORIDA BREEDERS

During the past year the number of thoroughbred breeding farms was increased considerably as several large breeders purchased acreage in Florida and moved their stock from northern states. The business of breaking and training of race horses is also on the increase as many yearlings are being shipped in for schooling in preparation for campaigns on the race tracks.

During 1956, Florida-breds won purses totaling nearly 1½ million dollars on all the tracks of the country. The winners bred in the Sunshine State were topped by "Needles", who earned \$440,850, and "King Hairan", with \$191,575.

The Florida Breeders Association, the turf writers, the racing associations and the Racing Commission are combining their efforts to publicize and promote the Sunshine State as an ideal location for breeding and training thoroughbreds.

#### CONCLUSION

We, the members of the Florida State Racing Commission, once again wish to express to you our deep appreciation for the trust and confidence you have placed in us, in appointing us to administer the racing laws of our State.

By accepting this responsibility, we have pledged ourselves to protect the public and the interest of the State at all times.




