



ADMINISTRATION

Kenneth Noe, Jr. served as Supervisor through November 20, 1961. W. Knox Eldredge has replaced him as Supervisor for the remainder of the period of this report and directs the many and varied activities of the Racing Commission.

The Auditing department is directed by George D. Johnson, Jr., Comptroller, and Elsie S. Bellows, Ph.D., supervises our fine laboratory. The Investigation department consisted of Tom C. Parker and Arthur T. Potter.

The records and statistics of all the racing activities in the State are kept in the Commission Offices located at 1350 N. W. 12th Avenue, Miami, Florida. This report contains but a small fraction of these records and any other data, too voluminous to be included in its entirety, will be gladly furnished upon request.

INVESTIGATIVE DIVISION

This Division continues to consider its primary responsibility to be the promotion and correlation of the law enforcement program of the racing industry. The best interests of racing and the protection of the public are kept in mind at all times. The Security and Investigative Division has worked very closely with law enforcement agencies at Federal, State, and local levels in exchanging information, records, and ideas to further strengthen the industry. Similar data are exchanged with Racing Commissions of other states when appropriate.

The Division performs many functions, all, however, concerned with the protection of the racing industry and the public. Enforcement of the so-called "85%" law is centered in this Division. This law requires that at least 85% of the employes at each track and fronton be bona-fide Florida residents and that 85% of weekly payrolls be paid to them, assuring that Florida residents are employed in a fair proportion of the positions at the tracks.

The responsibility of fingerprinting and photographing of officers, directors, association employees, and individuals engaged in racing operations, is centered in this Division. A complete file of fingerprints and photographs is maintained. During the past season 14,872 persons were issued occupational licenses. Of this number 1,424 were new personnel and were fingerprinted. Nine (9) felony records were disclosed through a search of these fingerprints in the Identification Division of the Federal Bureau of Investigation. Employment of persons with felony convictions was terminated in each instance when such employment was in conflict with the laws of Florida.

One hundred and ninety-five (195) bookmakers, touts, and other undesirables were ejected during the 1961-62 racing season by the various track and fronton security forces, in cooperation with the Security and Investigative Division. Investigations conducted by the Division were many and varied. These included background investigations of owners, trainers, and other persons applying for licenses who were new to Florida racing. Numerous investigations were conducted of individuals appealing their ejections from track premises. Any and all allegations of irregularities in racing operations were

investigated. Any indication of possible use of a stimulant or a depressant, and any attempt at corrupt or unethical practices were investigated with many miscellaneous complaints also being handled during this period. Racing kennels, track, and fronton premises were regularly inspected during the past season to assure that security and safety measures in force were being complied with at the times.

Through its regular reporting procedures the Security and Investigative Division has kept the Commission informed of the quality of operations and general conditions at the various tracks and frontons to insure that the industry and the public are being protected to the best of our ability.

LABORATORY

The Florida State Racing Commission Laboratory, the oldest of its kind in the United States, enjoys a top reputation among the racing laboratories of the world. Under the directorship of Dr. Elsie S. Bellows, its function is the detection of micro-quantities of drugs in saliva and urine which might be employed to affect the performance of the racing horse and greyhound.

Until the past few years these samples were analyzed for the usual stimulants, local anesthetics and drugs of a related nature. One general analysis was then considered adequate. In recent years, however, the use of analgesics in the horse, depressants in the greyhound and new drugs of special character in both racing animals, have made it necessary to perform special analyses in addition to the routine on many thousands of samples. For example, of the 9,836 samples received at the laboratory in the last fiscal year, 13,457 analyses were performed upon them. Of all these analyses only eleven were identified as positive samples.

In addition to its analytical program, the laboratory also maintains an active research program of new drug studies. It also conducts evaluations of new analytical methods and drug and metabolite excretion studies.

SCOPE OF RACING

State Revenue and the pari-mutuel handle surpassed all expectations for the 1961-62 racing season showing an increase in attendance of 6.4% and a 5.5% increase in the wagering.

For the first time in the history of Florida racing, revenues from all sources exceeded twenty-eight million dollars. Each of the sixty-seven counties of the State benefited by receiving a record \$201,800.00, of which \$155,800.00 was apportioned under the old racing laws and \$46,000.00 came from the additional taxes enacted by the 1955 Legislature. In addition, the Old Age Assistance program received nearly thirteen million dollars from racing. Another beneficiary of these racing revenues was our school system. Various exhibits of this report show in detail these distributions.

Although the sum of \$28,102,911.37 was collected by the Commission, only 2.1 per cent was expended in controlling, directing, and supervising the operations and activities of the twenty-seven licensees. The expenditures for the past year represented a saving of \$117,156.20 from the budget appropriation and this sum has been returned for distribution to the counties.

In order to better safeguard the collection of this revenue, your Commission has begun conducting a schooling and examining program for its track auditors which has proven most beneficial.

The mutuel handle and percentage of increase or decrease for each licensee was as follows:

ABANDONED PARI-MUTUEL TICKETS

Pursuant to Chapter 550.164, Florida Statutes, it was declared by the Legislature that all abandoned pari-mutuel tickets over one year of age should escheat to the State for deposit in the Principal of the State School Fund and to be used for the support and maintenance of our public free schools. A total of \$273,272.60 was received by the Commission during this fiscal year. Exhibit "E" of this report lists in detail the amounts remitted by the individual Associations.

SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Pursuant to Chapter 550.08, Florida Statutes, the Legislature authorized the various tracks and frontons to operate additional days of racing for the expressed purpose of creating and providing State scholarships for qualified applicants from the net profits derived therefrom. These scholarships are administered by the State Board of Control for Institutions of Higher Learning. A record total of \$408,652.45 was deposited to this fund during the past fiscal year. Exhibit "D" of this report lists the amounts raised by the participating licensees for this worthy project.

CHARITY DAYS

Pursuant to Chapter 550.03, Florida Statutes, the Legislature authorized the various tracks and frontons to operate extra days of racing, wherein the profits would go to recognized charities and institutions of higher learning not already participating in a scholarship day. Twenty-four tracks conducted such an extra day and a total of \$471,820.10 was raised for these organizations with the Commission supervising the distribution of this sum as follows:

LITIGATION

During the past year, the Florida State Racing Commission became involved in two pieces of Court litigation. The Commission revoked the license of Ponce de Leon Trotting Association, Inc. and denied the petition of South Florida Harness Raceways, Inc. to operate a harness track in Broward County as the transferee of the Ponce de Leon permit pursuant to Chapter 61-1940, Laws of 1961. This action by the Commission was brought before the Circuit Court of Leon County, Florida, on a petition for certiorari by the permit holder and transferee. On April 19, 1962, the Circuit Court of Leon County, Florida, entered an order quashing the Commission's order of revocation. The order of the Circuit Court of Leon County, Florida, is now being appealed by the Commission to the Supreme Court of Florida in order to secure a final determination of the Commission's revocation powers and also to secure a final determination of the constitutionality of Chapter 61, 1960, Laws of 1961.

The Commission was also made a party defendant to a suit brought in the Circuit Court of Duval County, Florida, by John Duncan against Jacob Watson and others. The Duval County Circuit Court sustained a motion by the Commission's attorney to dismiss the Commission as a party defendant to the suit which involved the ownership of certain greyhounds.

During the year, the Commission revoked or suspended a number of occupational licenses of owners, trainers, and jockeys, based on hearings before the Commission involving violations of the Commission's rules and regulations. None of these revocations or suspensions were appealed to the Courts. The Commission is continuing to vigorously enforce the governing statutes and its rules and regulations for the protection of the industry and the public.

FLORIDA BREEDERS

During 1961, Florida-bred thoroughbreds enjoyed their best year. More Florida-breds won races than in any previous season and the State again came up with a champion — the three-year-old CARRY BACK, winner of the Kentucky Derby and the Preakness Stakes. Total earnings make him the third leading money winner in the history of thoroughbred racing and he is one of only four horses to have earned more than a million dollars. This horse, in 1962, is a leading candidate for the championship in the handicap division.

Excellent performances by Florida-breds have encouraged a number of new interests to buy land for horse farm development in Central Florida. Some 16,000 acres in Marion County alone, now is devoted to the raising and training of thoroughbreds. Value of the farms and their buildings is estimated at \$15,000,000. Approximately 1,600 thoroughbreds populate the paddocks and barns: their combined value is estimated at \$20,000,000.

The Florida-bred preferred program was started in the 1961-62 racing season. This new legislation requires an average of one race per day at each track in which Florida-breds must be preferred as entries. Under the direction of F. G. (Pat) Farrell, Secretary of the Florida Thoroughbred Breeders' Association, and with the excellent co-operation of all tracks, the new program worked to near perfection.

The 5-pound weight allowance for Florida-breds, which had been in force by order of the Racing Commission for several years, was discontinued, upon recommendation, by the Florida Thoroughbred Breeders' Association.

The Florida Breeders' Sales Association's sale of 2-year-olds in training, held in January, 1962, at Hialeah, was the most successful one ever held by the organization. A total of 103 horses was sold for \$910,000, an average of \$8,835.

The 1962 crop of Florida-breds has suggested that it might possibly be the best group of horses ever sent trackward from Florida farms. With Floridabreds running as well as they are and with the market for Florida-breds stronger than ever, the outlook for the State's breeding industry is indeed a bright one.

CONCLUSION

We, the present members of the Florida State Racing Commission, express to you our appreciation for the trust and confidence which you have placed in us and assure you that we will always protect the public and the State's interest at all times and keep racing on the highest plane.
