



ADMINISTRATION

W. Knox Eldredge, Supervisor of Racing, and his assistants Dr. J. G. Catlett and L. F. Connor, Jr., supervise the many and varied activities of the Commission.

The Auditing Department is directed by George D. Johnson, Jr., Comptroller, and Elsie S. Bellows, Ph.Dd., supervises our fine laboratory. The Investigation Department is headed by Frank P. Kappel with Claude C. High as his assistant.

The records and statistics of all racing activities in the State are kept in the Commission office located at 1350 N. W. 12th Avenue, Miami, Florida. This report contains but a small fraction of these records and any other data, too voluminous to be included in its entirety, will be gladly furnished upon request.

INVESTIGATION DEPARTMENT

This Department, realizing its primary responsibility of promotion and correlation of the law enforcement program of this State's racing industry, has continued to strengthen its liaison with the law enforcement agencies and track security personnel.

The photographing and fingerprinting of 3,946 individuals engaged in racing, whose prints were not already on file with the Commission, was conducted by this Department. This resulted in a substantial increase in volume and a reduction in costs. Twenty-three (23) felony records were disclosed through a search of the Federal Bureau of Investigation records and said person's employment terminated when such employment was found to be in conflict with the laws of Florida.

A portable replica of this Agency's permanent fingerprint file was prepared and is being utilized in the field. A felony wanted list was also instituted and said list was distributed to track officials. Two hundred and ninety-two (292) bookmakers, touts and other undesirables were ejected during the year by the various track and fronton security forces in cooperation with this Department. A master list of these ejections is distributed to all tracks and kept current by periodic supplements.

Investigations conducted were many and varied with all information relevant being recorded and filed to keep the Commission advised of alleged illegal activities and the conditions that prevail at the tracks and frontons.

LABORATORY

The Commission Laboratory, oldest of its kind in the United States, enjoys a top reputation among the racing laboratories of the world. Its function is the detection of micro-quantities of drugs in the saliva and urine of racing animals which might affect their performance. Such samples are taken at the tracks by licensed Veterinarians who are employed by the Commission and are sent to the laboratory for analization.

During the year in review, 11,488 samples were received with a total of 16,314 analyses being performed upon them. Of all these analyses, only twenty-eight were identified as positive. In addition to its analytical program, the laboratory also maintains an active and continuous research program of new drug studies and conducts evaluations of new analytical methods and drug and metabolite excretion studies.

SCOPE OF RACING

The 1963-64 fiscal year showed phenomenal increases, breaking all previous records. Revenues increased 10.9%, attendance was up 13.9% and wagering increased 11.6% over the previous year.

Each of the sixty-seven counties of the State benefited by receiving a record \$234,000.00, of which \$176,600.00 was apportioned under the old racing laws and \$57,400.00 came from the additional taxes enacted by the 1955 Legislature. In addition, the General Revenue Fund from which the Old Age Assistance program is administered, received in excess of Fourteen Million Dollars from racing. Another beneficiary of the racing revenues was our school system. Various exhibits of this report show in detail these distributions.

Although the sum of \$33,125,470.58 was collected by the Commission, only 2.33% was expended in controlling, directing and supervising the operations and activities of the twenty-seven licensees. The expenditures for the past fiscal year represented a saving of \$47,969.23 from the budget appropriations and this sum has been returned for distribution to the counties.

During the year in review, Tourist Attractions, Inc., holders of the Key West permit, obtained permission under Chapter 63-130, Florida Statutes, to move their location to Pompano Beach where they conducted forty-six nights of harness racing. Seminole Park & Fairgrounds, Inc., which commenced operation in the Orlando area during the previous fiscal year, did not operate due to financial difficulties. West Flagler Kennel Club, Inc., assigned its permit to a limited partnership known as West Flagler Associates, Ltd. during the year.

The pari-mutuel handle, attendance and state revenue percentage of increase or decrease for each licensee was as follows:

ABANDONED PARI-MUTUEL TICKETS

Pursuant to Chapter 550.164, Florida Statutes, it was declared by the Legislature that all abandoned pari-mutuel tickets over one year of age should escheat to the State for deposit in the Principal of the State School Fund and to be used for the support and maintenance of our public free schools. Four-teen audits of these records were made during the fiscal year with a total of \$292,193.60 received by the Commission. Exhibit "E" of this report lists in detail the amounts remitted by the individual Associations.

SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Pursuant to Chapter 550.08, Florida Statutes, the Legislature authorized the various tracks and frontons to operate additional days of racing for the expressed purpose of creating and providing State scholarships for qualified applicants from the net profits derived on these extra days. These scholarships are administered by the State Board of Control for Institutions of Higher Learning. A total of \$399,898.11 was deposited to this fund during the past fiscal year. Exhibit "D" of this report lists the amounts raised by the participating licensees for this worthy project.

CHARITY DAYS

Pursuant to Chapter 550.03, 61-995, 63-680 and 63-738, Florida Statutes, the Legislature authorized the various tracks and frontons to operate extra days of racing, wherein the profits would go to recognized charities and institutions of higher learning not already participating in a scholarship day. Twenty-five tracks conducted such extra days and a total of \$617,425.39 was raised for these organizations with the Commission supervising the distribution of this sum as follows:

FLORIDA BREEDERS

During the year ending June 30, 1964, The Florida Thoroughbred breeding industry continued to show sharp gains. At the end of this period there were approximately 135 farms scattered throughout the state producing Thoroughbreds, with the largest concentration in the Ocala area. Exact foal production figures for 1964 are not yet available but, judging from foaling reports in the "Florida Horse", Florida will produce over 1000 foals this year, up over 200 from the sharply higher figure of 1963. The state's brood mare population is now approaching 2000 so it is expected this will move Florida into third place in the national foal production picture in 1965 if, in fact, this position was not actually reached this year.

The 1963-64 Florida-bred preferred race program continued to demonstrate its value in giving Florida-breds a better opportunity at Florida tracks. Florida-

The 1963-64 Florida-bred preferred race program continued to demonstrate its value in giving Florida-breds a better opportunity at Florida tracks. Florida-breds were preferred as entries in 121 races, won 61. Results from the 1963-64 program continued to show that preferred races are better than closed races since only 21 of the 121 races were filled with Florida-breds. This not only prevented horses bred in other states from being completely shut out, as is the case where closed races are in vogue, but it permitted tracks to schedule races without disturbing the usual quality of their programs.

A long list of Florida-breds performed well in stake races all over the country. Roman Brother was voted one of the outstanding two-year olds of 1963, continued to show his class at three when he won and placed in several top

stakes when in competition with the best horses of his age. A new star rose in the Florida skies when Cedar Key won the best grass stake at both Santa Anita and Gulfstream last winter, then continued his mastery on the turf when he moved north. Another new member of the Florida galaxy is two-year old Golden Joey, winner of most of the early season stakes for juveniles in Florida and New York.

LITIGATION

During the fiscal year ending June 30, 1963, the Florida State Racing Commission was a party to four (4) court proceedings, two of which were pending at the beginning of the year.

The litigation involving the constitutionality of Chapter 63-130, Laws of Florida 1963, under which the holder of the Key West Dog Track permit was licensed to conduct harness racing near Pompano in Broward County, Florida, was upheld by a decision of the Circuit Court of Leon County, Florida, and thereafter an appeal from this decision to the Supreme Court of Florida resulted in a final Supreme Court decision affirming the constitutionality of the

The appeal pending in the Circuit Court of Dade County, Florida, from the decision of the Commission fining William J. Hartack, Jr., was decided in favor of the appellant, Hartack, on the ground that the stewards of Gulfstream Park had failed to afford him due process of law in conducting their original

hearing in the case.

During the past year an action was brought by a protesting taxpayer attacking the constitutionality of Section 550.162, Florida Statutes, which grants to each dog track permiteee a daily "initial expense of operation" allowance of \$170.00 per race to be deducted from the 17% commission prior to the imposition of the tax of the pool and the clearing of same to the track operator. After numerous hearings before the Circuit Court of Dade County, Florida,

said matter is pending, awaiting final ruling from the court.

The final case in which the Commission is a party involves a ruling of the Tropical Park Stewards allowing the return of a horse entered as a colt by a person who claimed it, said return occurring after it was determined that the horse was in fact a monorchid. The ruling of the Stewards, which was upheld by the Commission, was that the horse had not been properly entered by its owner and trainer. This decision by the Commission has been appealed to the Third District Court of Appeal and is presently pending.

CONCLUSION

As our terms of office draw to a close, we would like to take this opportunity to express our sincere and genuine appreciation to all those persons employed by your Commission to carry out its mandates and functions. It is largely due to their loyalty and diligence that this State has experienced such a record year. We would also like to thank the many Associations for their cooperation and sincerely trust that this spirit will continue in the future.

We, the present members of the Florida State Racing Commission, again express to you our appreciation for the trust and confidence which you have placed in us and assure you that we will always protect the public and the State's interest at all times and shall endeavor to keep racing on the high

plane on which it has been conducted in the past.


