





#### ADMINISTRATION

Richard A. Kumble, Supervisor of Racing, represented the Commission in all administrative matters.

The Auditing Department is directed by George D. Johnson, Jr., Comptroller and Dr. Patrick H. Dougherty supervises our laboratory. The Investigation Department was headed by Gerald E. Shingledecker until April when Tom C. Parker took over the supervision of this department.

The records of all racing activities in the State are maintained and controlled at the Commission Office located in the State Office Building, 1350 N.W. 12th Avenue, Room 510, Miami, Florida. Since this report contains but a small fraction of these records, any additional information will be gladly furnished upon request.

#### PERMIT APPLICATIONS

The Racing Commission acted on the following applications to conduct racing filed during 1965-66:

West Coast Sports Association, Inc., Escambia County — This application was approved but subsequently ordered revoked by order of the Supreme Court of the State of Florida.

Gandy Operating Company, Inc., Hillsborough County — This application was approved but subsequently ordered revoked by order of the Supreme Court of the State of Florida.

Jai Alai Associates, Inc., Brevard County — This application was approved but defeated in a subsequent referendum held by the voters of Brevard County.

First Jai Alai Corporation, Duval County - This application was withdrawn, therefore no action was necessary.

The following new applications were filed during the month of June, 1967, and as of this writing, the Racing Commission had not acted upon them:

Keys Racing Association, Inc. filed an application to conduct greyhound racing in Monroe County.

Richard I. Berenson filed an application to conduct Jai Alai in Monroe County.

J. D. Muse and Walter H. Beck filed an application to conduct greyhound racing in Hamilton County.

#### SCOPE OF RACING

There are 29 permits to conduct pari-mutuel wagering in the varied fields of thoroughbred, harness, quarter horse, greyhound racing and jai alai frontons presently in good standing with the Florida State Racing Commission.

There is one inactive permit holder, Bayard Raceways, Inc. to which the permit of Ponce de Leon Raceway in Bayard, Florida was transferred with approval of the State Racing Commission in 1965. Ponce de Leon Raceway operated a harness and quarter horse meeting for three seasons and has been dormant for the past seven years.

Seminole Park and Fairgrounds, Inc. resumed operations during the year conducting thirty-one nights of thoroughbred and quarter horse racing.

The upward trend of recent years continued with State Tax Revenues derived from the pari-mutuel industry increasing 1.9%. The attendance at the pari mutuel sports was up .6% and the wagering was up 3%.

Each of the sixty-seven counties in the State benefited by receiving a record \$295,000 of which \$217,000 was apportioned under the old racing laws and \$78,000 came from the additional taxes enacted by the 1955 Legislature. The steady rise in the sums received by each county over the past five years is shown below.

In addition, the General Revenue Fund received in excess of sixteen million dollars from racing. This money was used to support the varied functions of the state government. Other beneficiaries of racing revenues were the State's school system and many charitable organizations. Various exhibits included in this report show these disbursements in detail.

Although the sum of \$40,219,585.65 was collected by the Commission during the fiscal year, only 2.4% was expended in controlling, directing and supervising the operation of the entire industry. Further economies were reflected in returning to the counties the sum of \$30,862.83 from the budgetary appropriations.

A recapitulation of the pari-mutuel handle, attendance and tax revenue amounts, along with the percentages of increase and/or decrease for each licensee is as follows:

#### ABANDONED PARI-MUTUEL TICKETS

Pursuant to Chapter 550.164, Florida Statutes, it was declared by the legislature that all abandoned pari-mutuel tickets over one year old should escheat to the State for deposit to the principal of the State School Fund. These funds are used for the support and maintenance of our public schools. Fifteen general audits were conducted during the fiscal year verifying the total of \$381,857.30 received by the Commission from this source. Exhibit "E" of this report shows in detail the amounts remitted by the individual associations.

The Racing Commission first began collecting these funds in 1957. The total revenues by yearly receipts are itemized below:

#### SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Pursuant to Chapter 550.08, Florida Statutes, the legislature authorized the various tracks and frontons to operate additional days of racing for the expressed purpose of creating and producing State Scholarships for qualified applicants. These funds are the net proceeds derived from these extra days of racing. This Scholarship Fund is administered by the State Board of Regents for Institutions of Higher Learning. A total of \$419,499.49 was deposited to this fund during the past fiscal year. Exhibit "D" of this report shows the amounts raised by the industry.

Since their inception eighteen years ago, these extra days have raised nearly six million dollars for our state supported colleges.

#### CHARITY DAYS

Since 1952, Florida Statutes have permitted the race tracks and frontons to operate additional days of racing, wherein the profits would go to recognized

charities and institutions of higher learning not already participating in a Scholarship Day. These funds are in addition to the other racing revenues detailed in this report by various exhibits. Twenty-six tracks and frontons participated during the year and conducted extra performances in which a record total of \$1,447,868.98 was raised for approved charitable organizations and schools. The Commission supervised the distribution of this sum to the following beneficiaries:

#### LEGISLATION

The 1967 session of the Florida State Legislature enacted several changes in the racing laws of Florida.

 Chapter 67-233, Laws of Florida 1967, amended Subsection (4) of Section 817.37, Florida Statutes, by adding thereto a provision relative to the return to a race track of any person after having been convicted of touting, etc., Subsection (4) as amended reading as follows:

Any person who has been convicted of touting by any court, and the record of whose conviction on such charge is on file in the office of the Florida State Racing Commission, any court of this state, or of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, or any person who has been ejected from any race track of this or any other state for touting or practices inimical to the public interest shall be

excluded from all race tracks in this state and if such person returns to a race track he shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than six (6) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Any such person who refuses to leave such track when ordered to do so by inspectors of the Florida State Racing Commission or by any peace officer, or by an accredited attache of the race track or association shall be guilty of a separate offense which shall be a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00).

 Chapter 67-540, Laws of Florida 1967, amended Section 550.03, Florida Statutes, by adding one additional day of racing to the current allocation for charitable purposes.

The Florida State Racing Commission was granted the authority to extend the limitations of time for horse tracks, dog tracks and Jai Alai frontons to conduct, in addition to the two (2) days heretofore provided, an additional third day for charity.

If said additional third day is conducted by a track or fronton located in Dade County the proceeds for charity purposes shall be allocated by payment of fifty per cent (50%) thereof to the University of Miami and fifty per cent (50%) to the degree-granting state college authorized under Section 239.012, Florida Statutes, to be established in Dade County.

If said additional third day is conducted by a track or fronton located in Sarasota or Manatee Counties the proceeds for charity purposes shall be allocated by payment to Manatee Junior College.

If said additional third day is conducted at any track or fronton in Palm Beach County, forty per cent (40%) of the proceeds for charitable purposes from such day shall be paid to Palm Beach Junior College, forty per cent (40%) of the proceeds for charitable purposes from such day shall be paid to Florida Atlantic University, and the remaining twenty per cent (20%) of the proceeds for charitable purposes from such day shall be paid to Marymount College.

If such additional day is conducted at any track or fronton in Escambia County fifty per cent (50%) of the proceeds for charitable purposes from such day shall be paid to the University of West Florida, and the remaining fifty per cent (50%) of the proceeds for charitable purposes from such day shall be paid to Pensacola Junior College.

3. Chapter 67-658, Laws of Florida 1967, authorized the Florida State Racing Commission to grant an extra day of racing to each horse track, dog track and Jai Alai fronton situated in counties in the state having a population of not less than Nine Hundred Thousand (900,000); and in counties having a population of not less than Four Hundred Thousand (400,000) nor more than Four Hundred Sixty-five Thousand (465,000) according to the latest official decennial census.

This extra day may be granted by the Racing Commission upon application and agreement by the owner or operator that all profits, less actual operating costs from such specific day's operation including all taxes payable to the state or any agency thereof for this extra day's operation shall be paid to the Board of Public Instruction of the counties affected.

These funds paid to such Boards shall be used solely for granting scholarships to the Continuing Education Centers presently under the direction of the Board of Regents in Dade County, Florida, and at Barry College in Dade County, Florida, said funds to be divided equally between said two (2) Educational Facilities.

It should be noted that these chapters became effective August 4, 1967 and are included for convenience purposes.

#### LITIGATION

During the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967, the Florida State Racing Commission was a party to four court proceedings.

 In the 1966 report, mention was made of the litigation wherein blacksmiths by and through their purported union and its president individually and in behalf of members of the same class (blacksmiths) sought to pursue their trade on the race tracks of Florida without compliance with the rule requiring fingerprinting before receiving an Occupational License.

Mention was also made of the fact that the action was resisted by the Commission and when the matter came on to be heard before the Circuit Court of Dade County, on the Commission's appropriate motions the Complaint was dismissed without prejudice at the request of the Plaintiff.

Thereafter the blacksmiths did again on October 27, 1966, challenge the right of the Commission to require individual blacksmiths to be fingerprinted and photographed before receiving an Occupational License to work on race horses in the race tracks of this state by bringing another Complaint for Declaratory Decree in the Circuit Court of Dade County.

The Commission again resisting the action brought a Motion to Dismiss the Complaint and a Motion for Summary Final Decree.

Subsequent to oral argument, the Circuit Court of Dade County entered a Summary final Decree on the 3rd day of March, 1967, in favor of the Respondents, the Florida State Racing Commission. There was no appeal brought from this decision.

 The West Coast Sports Association, Inc., made application to the Florida State Racing Commission for a permit to operate a Jai Alai fronton in Escambia County.

The Commission authorized issuance of said permit on August 12, 1966, and the same was duly issued on August 22, 1966.

Pensacola Greyhound Racing, Inc., (holder of a permit to conduct dog races) in Escambia County, did on the 15th day of November, 1966, file a Petition for Alternative Writ of Mandamus and Brief in support thereof in the Supreme Court of Florida seeking to have the court command the Racing Commission to cancel and annul the said permit granted to the West Coast Sports Association, Inc., as being in contravention of statutory distance limitations between pari mutuel associations.

The Commission filed appropriate pleadings and brief in opposition to the Petition for Alternative Writ of Mandamus and after oral argument the Supreme Court of the State of Florida, did by opinion, filed February 8, 1967, grant the Petition for Alternative Writ of Mandamus.

3. On August 22, 1966, the Florida State Racing Commission, pursuant to application therefor, issued a second permit to Gandy Operating Co., Inc., to operate its Jai Alai fronton in Tampa, Florida during the summer season. On November 18, 1966, the Commission granted Gandy Operating Co., Inc., a license under said second permit to conduct Jai Alai performances from May 6, through September 4, 1967. Gandy Operating Co., Inc., was the holder of a permit granted by the Florida State Racing Commission on July 12, 1952, and received annual licenses to conduct Jai Alai performances each winter season, the last dates being February 3, 1967 through June 10, 1967.

Associated Outdoor Clubs, Inc., (holder of a permit to operate dog racing in Hillsborough County) brought an original Writ of Mandamus in the Supreme Court of Florida seeking a peremptory Writ commanding the Commission to cancel and annul the said second permit for summer Jai Alai together with the license awarding dates thereunder.

The Commission filed a return to the Alternative Writ of Mandamus, Motion to Quash and supporting brief.

Subsequent to oral argument the Supreme Court did by opinion filed on April 12, 1967, grant the peremptory Writ of Mandamus.

4. Judge Louie Bandel was commissioned as a member of the Florida State Racing Commission on February 2, 1965, by the Honorable Haydon Burns then Governor of the State of Florida. On January 22, 1965, the then Racing Commission pursuant to the statute which provides that "...the Commissioners shall select from among their number a Chairman..." elected Judge Bandel as Chairman. On June 15, 1966, the Commissioners did at regular meeting, through majority vote declare the position of Chairman vacant and did "select from among their number" Robert C. Lechner as Chairman. Commissioner Lechner served as Chairman for some nine months, until his term as a member of the Florida State Racing Commission expired by reason of his not being confirmed by the Senate early in 1967. Thereafter James W. Taylor having been appointed as a member of the Florida State Racing Commission by the Honorable Claude Kirk, Governor of the State of Florida was duly elected by the majority of the

Commissioners as Chairman of the Commission at a regular meeting of the Commission held on February 17, 1967.

On June 8, 1967, Judge Louie Bandel (member of the Florida State Racing Commission) brought a Quo Warranto action in the Circuit Court of Dade County against James W. Taylor as the purported Chairman of the Florida State Racing Commission and L. B. Walker, James L. Lee, Sr. and Martin Segal as Racing Commissioners, seeking to have the court enter a judgment of ouster against James W. Taylor as Chairman of the Florida State Racing Commission and determine the rights of Judge Louie Bandel to the office of Chairman of the Florida State Racing Commission and to all compensations and emoluments thereof. This matter is now pending in the Circuit Court of Dade County.

#### INVESTIGATION DIVISION

In the interest of the protection of the public, the Racing Commission maintains an investigation division whose duty it is to enforce the Laws of Florida and the Rules and Regulations of Racing as promulgated by the Commission.

This department works closely with the local law enforcement agencies and the associations' own security forces to effectively promote and correlate the investigation of all illegal activities on the race tracks and frontons of Florida.

During this past fiscal year, 397 undesirables were ejected from the grounds of the various associations and 407 investigations were held for such various matters as illegal medications, patron reinstatements, etc., as a result of this close cooperation.

This department also concerns itself with the enforcement of the commonly called "85% Law". This law requires that at least 85% of the employees at each track or fronton be bona fide Florida residents and that 85% of the weekly payroll be paid to them. This law assures local residents of a fair proportion of the jobs at each track.

In order to better control the racing laws, all persons licensed are required to furnish the Commission with their fingerprints and photograph. The Investigation division is responsible for the supervision of this activity and a complete file of all such fingerprints and photographs is kept current. During the past season, 20,635 occupational licenses were issued. Of this number 8,997 represented new licensees.

During fiscal 1965-66 a master record of all persons having fingerprints and photographs on file with the Commission was published for use in the field. During fiscal 1966-67, this list was updated through the use of data processing equipment. This master list has proven to be an invaluable aid in the field and it now includes some 32,718 persons.

#### LABORATORY

The Commission Laboratory, the oldest of its kind in the United States, enjoys a top reputation among the racing laboratories of the world. Its function is the detection of micro quantities of drugs in the saliva and urine of racing animals which might affect their performance. Such samples are taken by licensed veterinarians who are employed by the Commission.

During the year in review, a record 19,005 samples were received with a total of 23,637 analyses being performed on them. The cost per sample was \$3.15. Of these samples only eight were identified as chemically positive. In addition to its analytical purposes, the laboratory also maintains an active and continuous research program of new drugs. It also conducts evaluations of new analytical methods and metabolite excretion studies.

#### FLORIDA BREEDING

The Florida Breeding Industry continued its amazing expansion during the last twelve months.

Where only three horse farms were located in Marion County in 1946, there are now 111 nurseries which this year produced a record crop of more than 1,500 foals. Florida continues to rank in third place in the nation, behind only Kentucky and California.

Florida's ideal climate for breeding and training horses is certain to attract even more breeding farms. The favorable conditions under which Florida-bred horses race in Florida will continue to benefit the industry. Each racing day at each Florida track, an average of one race is run with Florida-breds as preferred entries. This gives Florida-breds greater opportunity to run at home yet it does not penalize horses bred in other states and brought to Florida for the winter racing season.

#### CONCLUSION

We, the members of the Florida State Racing Commission, express to you our appreciation for the trust and confidence which you have placed in us. We assure you that we will always protect the interest of the public, members of the various phases of the racing industry, and the State of Florida, by seeing to it that racing is conducted in only the highest possible manner.


