



In compliance with the requirements of Chapter 550.02, subsection 2, Florida Statutes, the Florida State Racing Commission submits this, its Thirty-Seventh Annual Report for the period beginning July 1, 1967, and ending with the close of business on June 30, 1968.

James W. Taylor served as Chairman and L. B. Walker served as Secretary from July 1, 1967 until March 22, 1968.

L. B. Walker was elected Chairman and L. D. Plante was elected Secretary on March 22, 1968, and served through the end of the report period.

Judson A. Samuels served as Commission Attorney for this entire period.

PERMIT APPLICATIONS

No new applications were filed during this period. However, the Racing Commission acted on the following applications to conduct racing and jai-alai which were filed during the 1966-67 season:

KEYS RACING ASSOCIATION, Monroe County. This application was approved by the Commission and was subsequently ratified by the voters of Monroe County. It is anticipated that this track will commence its greyhound racing activities during the coming season.

RICHARD I. BERENSON, Application to conduct Jai-Alai in Monroe County. This application was withdrawn; therefore, no action was necessary.

J. D. MUSE and WALTER H. BECK, Hamilton County. This application for greyhound racing was not in order; therefore, no action was taken.

No new applications were filed during June of 1968 and none are pending before the Commission at this time.

PERMIT HOLDERS

Racing activities during the year in review were conducted by 27 active permit holders operating under licenses issued by your Commission. Sixteen permit holders operate greyhound tracks, six operate jai-alai frontons, four operate thoroughbred horse tracks and one operates a harness track. Detailed statistical analysis of each of these operations are included as Exhibits to this report.

There are three inactive permits:

One as mentioned above having just been ratified by the electors in Monroe County, and which is expected to become operative during the coming year (KEYS RACING ASSOCIATION).

One has been issued for SEMINOLE PARK AND FAIRGROUNDS, INC., a horse track in Casselberry which operated 31 days during 1967, but due to financial difficulties, was dormant during the past year. It is anticipated this track will again open in 1969.

The other permit is issued to BAYARD RACEWAYS, INC., which holds the right to conduct racing at Ponce de Leon Raceway, Bayard, Florida. This track has been dormant for the past eight years.

One Permit Holder, HIALEAH RACE COURSE, INC., lost one day from its season. As part of a nationwide trend toward obtaining higher purses at the horse tracks, the horsemen refused to enter at this track on opening day. Through the mediation efforts of your Commission this matter was quickly resolved between management and the horsemen.

ADMINISTRATION

George D. Johnson, Jr., Supervisor of Racing, administers the many and varied activities of the Commission. He was ably assisted by Dr. P. H. Dougherty, Laboratory Director; Tom C. Parker, Chief Investigator; and Tom G. Ozmer, Jr., Administrative Assistant.

The records of all racing activities in the State are maintained and controlled at the Commission Office located in the State Office Building, 1350 N. W. 12th Avenue, Room 510, Miami, Florida. Since this report contains but a small fraction of these records, any additional information will be gladly furnished upon request.

In accordance with your wishes, the Commission has authorized an In-Depth Study of the Pari-Mutuel Industry by the First Research Corporation of Miami. This study is to cover the present structure and project over a 10-year period into the future. We feel this study will be most beneficial in our administering of Statutes and Rules. It is anticipated the report will be completed sometime during the Fall months.

In modernizing and updating procedures, the following programs were instituted during the year in review:

The roving concept for State Inspectors at the tracks was put into effect, giving better coverage with fewer personnel. Also, State Inspectors are now identified by arm bands and name tags, and carry complaint books for the convenience of the betting public in registering their comments. Each such form received has been investigated and the individual submitting same has been notified by means of a personal letter of the results of such investigation.

In order to effect a closer working relationship between those State employees working in the Miami office and at the tracks a policy of holding training Seminars was begun during the spring, with the first being held during April in Panama City. It is planned to make this a part of our regular orientation for new State track employees.

Our Staff has undertaken a complete review of all Rules and Regulations. During this fiscal year the Pari-Mutuel Rules were consolidated into one Rule Book and the Greyhound Rule Book was updated. A good start has been made on the Horse, Harness and Jai-Alai Books, which we plan to complete during the coming year.

During the summer months we took delivery of an electronic accounting machine, and a revamp of our Agency's accounting methods and procedures has been completed.

INVESTIGATION DEPARTMENT

In order to better protect the public the Racing Commission maintains an investigation department whose duty is to enforce the laws of Florida and the rules and regulations of racing as promulgated by the Commission. This department works closely with the local law enforcement agencies and the tracks' own security forces to effectively promote and correlate the investigation of all illegal activities at the race tracks and frontons of the State.

This department also concerns itself with the enforcement of the commonly called "85% law" which requires that at least this percentage of the employees at each track or fronton be bona fide Florida residents and that such a percentage of the weekly payroll be paid to them. This law assures local residents of a fair opportunity for employment at the tracks.

During the past fiscal year this Agency, together with the various track security departments, was instrumental in the ejection of 226 undesirables from the grounds of the various associations, and 97 investigations were conducted on such other matters as illegal medications, patron reinstatements, etc.

For the first time, a complete and current list consisting of over 70 legal size pages of all persons ejected from Florida Tracks for the period July 1, 1962 through April 30, 1968, was compiled and distributed to General Managers and Track Security personnel of all Associations, the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the Thoroughbred Racing Protective Bureau, the United States Trotting Association and Commission Investigators. We feel this to be an important part of your War on Crime.

The Statutes require that all persons employed in the industry be licensed, fingerprinted and photographed. The Investigation Department is responsible for the supervision of this activity and, through the use of data processing equipment, maintains a complete up-to-date record on each person. During the past season 21,020 occupational licenses were issued. Of this number 6,347 persons required new fingerprints and photographs.

LABORATORY

The Commission Laboratory, the oldest of its kind in the United States, enjoys a top reputation among the racing laboratories of the world. Its function is the detection of micro quantities of drugs in the saliva and urine of racing animals which might affect their performance. Such samples are taken by licensed veterinarians who are employed by the Commission.

During the year in review a record 22,357 samples were received, with a total of 25,921 analyses being performed on them. The cost per sample was \$2.93. Of these samples only 11 (6 horse and 5 dog) were identified as chemically positive and appropriate investigative action taken. In addition to its analytical purposes, the laboratory also maintains an active and continuous research program of new drugs. It also conducts evaluations of new analytical methods and metabolite excretion studies.

NATIONAL COORDINATION

Members of the Florida State Racing Commission are members of the National Association of State Racing Commissioners, an organization made up on Commissioners from all of the various States having legalized Parimutuel activities. Through the exchange of information and ideas, the National Association is of great benefit to each member of the Association. Under a reciprocity agreement, each State recognizes rulings made by any other State Racing Board.

The 1968 Convention was held in Bal Harbour, Florida, where Florida was honored by the election of our Chairman, L. B. Walker, to the office of Treasurer of the National Association.

The Association of Official Racing Chemists also held their Convention in conjunction with the National Association. Florida was represented by Dr. P. H. Dougherty.

SCOPE OF RACING

Florida truly reached a golden era in all aspects of racing during this fiscal year, and every trend indicates that the State's resident increase in population, plus the expanding tourist industry, will continue to generate such future growth.

Revenues increased 9.3%; attendance was up 4.9%, and the total Parimutuel wagering showed an increase of 9.4% over the pervious record setting year. Each of the 67 counties of the State benefited by receiving a record \$319,000, of which \$233,000 was apportioned under the old racing laws and \$86,000 came from the additional taxes enacted by the 1955 Legislature. The steady rise in the sums received by each county over the past five years is shown below:

1968 — \$319,000 1967 — 295,000 1966 — 290,000 1965 — 262,500 1964 — 234,000 Further economies in our Agency's operation were reflected in returning to the counties the sum of \$99,761.43 from the Budgetary Appropriations. In addition, the General Revenue Fund received in excess of \$18,000,000 from racing. This money was used to support the varied functions of our State Government. Other beneficiaries of State revenues were the State School System and many charitable organizations. Various Exhibits included in this report show these distributions in detail.

Although the sum of \$44,151,816.75 was collected by the Commission during the fiscal year, only 2.2% was expended in controlling, directing and supervising the operation of the entire Pari-mutuel industry.

ABANDONED PARI-MUTUEL TICKETS

Pursuant to Chapter 550.164, Florida Statutes, it was declared by the legislature that all abandoned pari-mutuel tickets over one year old should escheat to the State for deposit to the Principal of the State School Fund. These funds are used for the support and maintenance of our public schools. Eight general audits were conducted during the fiscal year verifying the total of \$448,161.00 received by the Commission from this source. Exhibit "F" of this report shows in detail the amounts remitted by the individual associations.

The Racing Commission first began collecting these funds in 1957. The total revenues by yearly receipts are itemized below:

SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Pursuant to Chapter 550.08, Florida Statutes, the Legislature authorized the various tracks and frontons to operate additional days of racing for the express purpose of creating and producing State Scholarships for qualified applicants. These funds are the net proceeds derived from these extra days of racing. This Scholarship Fund is administered by the State Board of Regents for Institutions of Higher Learning. A total of \$541,389.12 was deposited to this fund during the past fiscal year. Exhibit "D" of this report shows the amounts raised by the industry.

Since their inception nineteen years ago, these extra days have raised over 6½ million dollars for our state supported colleges.

CHARITY DAYS

Since 1952, Florida Statutes have permitted the race tracks and frontons to operate additional days of racing, wherein the profits would go to recognized charities and institutions of higher learning not already participating in a Scholarship Day. These funds are in addition to the other racing revenues detailed in this report by various exhibits. Twenty-seven tracks and frontons participated during the year and conducted extra performances in which a record total of \$1,837,697.14 was raised for approved charitable organizations and schools. The Commission supervised the distribution of this sum to the following beneficiaries:

LITIGATION

During the Fiscal year ending June 30, 1968, the Florida State Racing Commission was party to two Court proceedings.

1. In the 1967 Report, mention was made of the litigation wherein Judge Louie Bandel (then member of the Florida State Racing Commission) brought a Quo Warranto action in the Circuit Court of Dade County against James W. Taylor, as the purported Chairman of the Florida State Racing Commission and L. B. Walker, James L. Lee, Sr., and Martin Segal, as Racing Commissioners, seeking to have the Court enter a Judgment of Ouster against James W. Taylor, as then Chairman of the Florida State Racing Commission and determine the rights of Judge Louie Bandel to the office of Chairman of the Florida State Racing Commission and to all compensations and emoluments thereof, said matter being then pending in the Circuit Court.

Subsequent to trial, the Circuit Court of Dade County entered a Final Decree in favor of the respondents, the Florida State Racing Commission. Thereafter the Petitioner, Judge Louie Bandel, filed a Notice of Appeal,

Assignments of Error and Directions to the Clerk, to the District Court of Appeal, Third District of Florida. The respondents filed Cross-Assignments of Error and subsequent thereto did file a Motion to Dismiss the Appeal for Petitioner's failure to comply with rule 3.7(a), Florida Appellate Rules, in that the Petitioner's Brief had not been filed. The matter was heard on oral argument made by respondent resulting in the dismissal of the Appeal.

2. On the 23rd day of August, 1966, Gulfstream Park Racing Association, Inc., brought an action against the Florida State Racing Commission, a State Agency; and the members thereof constituting the Florida State Racing Commission; Hialeah Race Course, Inc., and Tropical Park, Inc., in the Circuit Court of the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, Broward County, Florida.

Plaintiff is seeking by this action to have the Court declare Section 3 of Chapter 23728, Laws of Florida, 1947, now being Section 550.081(3), Florida Statutes to be unfair, arbitrary, discriminatory and unconstitutional.

The said Section provides in substance that the horse race track having produced the largest amount of tax revenue during the previous year of its operation shall be granted its choice of the three established racing periods (three 40 day periods commencing on December 1st of each year and continuing for a full period of 120 consecutive days, 550.081(2)). The horse race track having produced the second largest amount of tax revenue during the previous year of its operation shall be granted its choice of the remaining two established racing periods. The horse race track having produced the third largest amount of tax revenue during the previous year of its operation shall be allocated the period remaining after the two tracks producing the largest amount of tax revenue shall have made their selections.

Gulfstream Park Racing Association, Inc. alleges that since the inception of said legislation the practical result thereof has been to perpetuate the first choice of racing periods in Hialeah Race Course, Inc., and seeks to vest the power to award the three racing periods to Hialeah Race Course, Inc., Tropical Park, Inc., and Gulfstream Park Racing Association, Inc., in the Florida State Racing Commission, the same to be awarded by the Commission annually on a fair and equitable basis.

Subsequent to the inception of the litigation the Defendants, Hialeah Race Course, Inc., and Tropical Park, Inc. brought a Motion to Transfer, whereupon Gulfstream Park Racing Association, Inc., Plaintiff, did secure a voluntary Order of Dismissal against the Defendants, Hialeah Race Course, Inc., and Tropical Park Racing Association, Inc. The said two defendants did then petition the Circuit Court in Broward County for leave to intervene, and the same being granted, Hialeah Race Course, Inc., and Tropical Park Racing Association, Inc., did then bring Motions for Dismissal or Transfer, which after argument were denied by the Court.

Hialeah Race Course, Inc., and Tropical Park Racing Association, Inc. did then enter an Interlocutory Appeal from the Order of the Circuit Court denying their said Motions to Dismiss or Transfer, to the Supreme Court of Florida accompanying the same with pertinent briefs and request for oral argument.

The Supreme Court of Florida did, by Order dated February 2, 1968, determine that the issues involved were matters within the jurisdiction of the District Court of Appeals for the Fourth District of Florida, and ordered that the cause be transferred to said District Court for consideration and determination.

Thereafter and pursuant to the mandate of the Supreme Court, the Interlocutory Appeals were heard by the said District Court of Appeal on briefs and oral argument and the same was by opinion rendered in the January term, 1968, denied, the Order of the Circuit Court having been affirmed. The Florida State Racing Commission filed its appearance on the 5th day of October, 1967, and its answer on December 13, 1967, wherein after admitting, denying, and/or neither admitting nor denying, but demanding strict proof in respect of the various allegations contained in the Complaint, did affirmatively plead that any and all actions taken or contemplated by the Florida State Racing Commission in the premises under and pursuant to Chapter 23728, Laws of Florida, 1947, which subsequently became Sections 550.081, 550.081(8 2) and 550.081(3), Florida Statutes, was or would be so undertaken pursuant to and in accord with a valid, duly enacted state statute, being enrolled and a part of the organic laws of the State of Florida.

The Florida State Racing Commission did file pertinent documents in the Interlocutory Appeals and Counsel for the Commission did attend the oral arguments heard before the District Court of Appeal, of the State of Florida, Fourth District.

The cause is now pending before the Circuit Court of the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit, in and for Broward County, Florida, the same having been set for trial on the 15th and 16th day of October, 1968.

FLORIDA BREEDING

The last twelve months have seen a continued expansion of the Thoroughbred breeding industry in Florida, and more laurels for Florida-bred runners in major stakes competition throughout the country.

Tartan Farms' Dr. Fager joined the list of Florida-bred champions, being selected as the Champion Sprinter of 1967.

Florida breeders grouped, in the spirit of cooperation which has made the industry such a success, in obtaining breeding stock sought by selective breeders in all parts of the world.

The farm area in Marion County, seat of the state's breeding industry, continued to grow, and more and more farms have been built in other sections of the state. There were only three farms in Marion County; now there are some 125 in operation or under construction.

Another record crop of foals was reported by the Florida Thoroughbred Breeders' Association. The Florida Breeders' Sales Company reported sales at auction of almost \$6,000,000 during the state's sales period from October, 1967, through March, 1968, evidence that Florida is definitely established as one of the nation's top market places for Thoroughbreds.

CONCLUSION

We, the members of the Florida State Racing Commission, express to you our appreciation for the trust and confidence which you have placed in us. We assure you that we will always protect the interest of the public, members of the various phases of the racing industry, and the State of Florida, by seeing to it that racing is conducted in only the highest possible manner.


