



Dear Sir:

The Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering hereby submits this Forty-Fourth Annual Report for the period beginning July 1, 1974, and ending with the close of business June 30, 1975, in compliance with the requirements of Chapter 550.02, Subsection 2 of the Florida Statutes.

This Division is one of five in the Department of Business Regulation, under the Board of Business Regulation. J. Patrick McCann is the Director, administering the varied activities of the Division.

The able assistance of Daniel W. MacPherson, Pari-Mutuel Operations Coordinator; Dr. W. Dale Snyder, Racing Research and Laboratory Manager; Mrs. Lillian Meisner, Administrative Assistant; Mr. Ernest L'Heureux, Chief Investigator; and Mrs. Dolores Wagner, Licensing Administrator, is hereby acknowledged.

Dr. P. H. Dougherty retired on November 8, 1974, as Racing Research and Laboratory Manager, after having served the Divison and the State Racing Commission for ten years, and Mr. Thomas P. Garvey resigned as Chief Investigator on February 6, 1975. The assistance of both these individuals is also acknowledged.

Legal services were ably provided by the Legal Section of the Department of Business Regulation, under the direction of General Counsel William D. Moore. J. Riley Davis, of the legal staff, represents the State most capably at Division hearings. The Division also wishes to recognize the assistance given to this office on legal matters by Mr. James D. Whisenand, Assistant Attorney General.

The Governor's Thoroughbred Advisory Committee, under the direction of Chairman Robert F. Mackle, also ably assisted the Division on thoroughbred racing matters, and their assistance is gratefully acknowledged.

A Greyhound Advisory Committee, chaired by Dr. George Simmons, was appointed by Mr. Richard A. Pallot, Chairman of the Board of Business Regulation, on April 2, 1975, and have ably assisted the Division on problems relating to greyhound racing.

The records of all pari-mutuel activities in this state are maintained at the Division office, located in the State Office Building, 1350 N.W. 12th Avenue, Suite 510, Miami, Florida 33136. Since this report contains but a small fraction of these records, any additional information will gladly be furnished upon request.

The Division held twelve formal meetings to hear appeals and matters concerning reinstatement, licensing, and rule amendments on the following dates: July 16, August 13, September 18, September 26, October 22, November 26, 1974, and January 21, March 13, April 24, June 24, 1975 (all in Miami); October 25, 1974 (Ocala Jai-Alai, Inc.); and January 10, 1975 (in Tampa).

INVESTIGATION SECTION

The investigative section works closely with local, state and federal law enforcement agencies and the pari-mutuel associations' security forces to promote and correlate effectively investigations of any illegal activities at the race tracks and frontons within the state.

The late J. Edgar Hoover once stated: "... Cooperation is the backbone of law enforcement." This Division adheres closely to the principles of that statement. Mutual exchanges of information pertaining to pari-mutuel installations occur on an almost daily basis between this Division and local, state and federal law enforcement agencies.

All matters regarding positive specimen reports are assigned immediately, and logical investigation is conducted on a priority basis. The goal of the investigation is to bring responsible persons before the stewards and judges for appropriate action. As a result of investigations conducted by Division personnel, our investigators appeared at seventy-two stewards/judges hearings. Investigators from the Division work very closely with the stewards and judges at the various associations.

A substantial amount of time is spent in background investigations in connection with referrals, reinstatements, licensing, license denials, and license pickups. Each of these matters involves the preparation of a report. In the past year reports were prepared in one hundred forty-eight matters heard at Division hearings.

Because of the recurrent allegations on an almost daily basis, of the infiltration of organized crime into successful enterprises, the Division is alert to such possibility in a pari-mutuel installation. It maintains close liaison with criminal intelligence sections of state and federal enforcement agencies. An investigator from this Division is a member of the Tri-County Organized Crime Group in South Florida and meets on a regular basis with that group.

An investigation, conducted by track security, the Investigative Staff of the Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering, and the Organized Crime Bureau of the Dade

County Public Safety Department, resulted in conviction of an individual for dog race fixing for which he was sentenced to three years in prison.

An investigation conducted by the Investigative Staff of the Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering and local law enforcement agencies from Pinellas County resulted in charges against another individual on three counts of grand larceny for which subject was sentenced to five years on each count to run concurrently. This individual was also charged with arson by the Marion County authorities, was convicted, and sentenced to ten years. This case developed from an investigation of the apparent killing of 24 greyhound dogs at St. Petersburg Kennel Club.

In the past year, three hundred eighty-seven persons were ejected from the state's pari-mutuel associations.

Numerous patron complaints were investigated.

Investigators attend roll calls at all the associations and assist in the licensing procedures. They periodically visit the associations and, over all, assist in any way possible:

LICENSE SECTION

Florida Statutes require that all persons in the industry be licensed, fingerprinted, and photographed. The Licensing Section is responsible for the supervision of this activity and, through the use of data processing equipment, maintains a complete up-to-date record of each person. During the past season, 31,093 occupational licenses were issued. A total of 10,608 persons were fingerprinted, making a total of approximately 93,000 on file.

This section also concerns itself with the enforcement of Florida Statute 550.27, commonly called the "85% Law," which requires that a least this percentage of the employees at each track or fronton be bona fide Florida residents and that such a percentage of the weekly payroll be paid to them. This Law assures local residents of a fair opportunity for employment at the pari-mutuel establishments.

A record of rulings from all jurisdictions is kept: 1,692 rulings were processed in 1974-1975.

LABORATORY

The Division Laboratory, which is the oldest of its kind in the United States, enjoys a reputation of high esteem among the racing laboratories of the world. Its function is to detect micro quantities of drugs in samples of blood, saliva, or urine, which might affect the performances of racing animals. These samples are taken under the supervision of licensed veterinarians employed by the Division.

During this period, a record 33,166 samples were received, with a total of 54,654 analyses performed on them. The cost per sample was \$4.38; per analysis was \$2.66. Of these samples, sixteen were identified as chemically positive, and appropriate investigative and disciplinary action was taken.

In addition to its analytical purposes, the laboratory also maintains an active and continuous research program of new drugs. It also conducts evaluations of new analytical methods of metabolite excretion studies.

The Division continued its controlled medication program, which permits the use of therapeutic drugs to be administered to horses under controlled conditions. This program continues to put an additional testing burden on the laboratory.

SCOPE OF PARI-MUTUELS

Once again all existing records were broken. State pari-mutuel tax revenue increased 5.5%, attendance increased 7.5%, and gross pari-mutuel wagering increased 5.8%.

Florida had a record number of 4,430 pari-mutuel performances during the past fiscal year, far outdistancing any state in the country in this category.

The sum of \$83,919,328.57 was collected from all sources by the Division during the fiscal year. Of this amount 2.1% was expended in controlling, directing, and supervising the operation of the entire industry.

The sum of \$29,915,500.00 was distributed to the 67 counties, each receiving \$446,500.00. This is the maximum amount permitted because of a ceiling placed on such distribution by the 1971 Legislature.

An additional amount of \$14,428,322.08, which, under the former statute would have been distributed to the counties, was deposited in the State General Revenue Fund.

In addition, in excess of \$32,544,174.41 was deposited in the State General Revenue Fund to support the varied functions of our state government.

Other monies were distributed to the Racing Promotional Trust Fund, Racing Scholarships Trust Fund, State School Trust Fund, and the Bicentennial Trust Fund, as enumerated elsewhere in this report.

A recapitulation of the pari-mutuel handle, attendance, and tax revenue amounts, along with the percentages of increase and/or decrease for each licensee, is found on page 14.

PERMIT HOLDERS

Thirty-six valid permits have been granted to conduct pari-mutuel wagering in the varied fields of horse racing, greyhound racing and jai-alai, all under the jurisdiction of the Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering.

Pari-Mutuel activities were conducted by thirty-five permit holders during the past fiscal year. Seventeen operated greyhound tracks, nine operated jai-alai frontons, five operated thoroughbred horse tracks, two operated harness tracks, and two conducted quarter horse racing. Detailed statistical analyses of each are included in the exhibits of this report.

Bayard Raceways, a permittee, requested and was granted approval by the Board of Business Regulation not to operate for the 1974-1975 fiscal year.

Columbia Jai-Alai, Inc. was granted a permit on December 4, 1974; however, this was not ratified by the voters in Columbia County.

The following applications for permits were received by the Division in June, 1974, to be considered by the Board of Business Regulation in August:

CHARITY DAYS

Thirty-one tracks and frontons operated a total of 164 extra performances during the fiscal year for approved charitable organizations and schools.

SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Pursuant to Chapter 550.08, Florida Statutes, the Legislature authorized the various tracks and frontons to operate additional days for the express purpose of creating and producing state scholarships for qualified applicants. These funds are the net proceeds derived from the extra days. This scholarship fund is administered by the State Board of Regents for institutions of higher learning. A total of \$835,385.51 was deposited to this fund in the past fiscal year. Exhibit "C" of this report shows the amounts raised by the industry.

Since their inception twenty-five years ago, these extra days have raised over ten million dollars for our state-supported colleges.

ABANDONED PARI-MUTUEL TICKETS

Pursuant to Chapter 550.164, Florida Statutes, it was declared by the Legislature that all abandoned pari-mutuel tickets over one year old should escheat to the state for deposit to the Principal of the State School Fund. These funds are used for the support and maintenance of our public schools. A total of \$1,288,317.65 was received from this source by the Division throughout the

fiscal year, and related audits were made. Exhibit "H" of this report shows in detail the amounts remitted by the individual associations.

LEGISLATION

The following Bills were passed that relate to racing and pari-mutuel wagering:

- 1) Chapter 75-42, Laws of Florida 1975; amended Sections 550.16(2), 550.162(2), 550.42(3), and 551.09(2), Florida Statutes, to increase the commission on a pari-mutuel pool from 17 to 17.4 percent.
- 2) Chapter 75-43, Laws of Florida 1975; amended 550.081, 550.41 and created a new Section to Chapter 550, Florida Statutes; relating to special winter common purse pool, summer racing purse allowance, purse allowance, and extending winter thoroughbred racing dates.
- Chapter 75-142, Laws of Florida 1975; amended 550.33(7) Florida Statutes; quarter horse racing; relating to the substitution of races of other breeds of horses.
- Chapter 75-363 (Local Bill); amended Section 1 and repealed Sections 2,
 and 4 of Chapter 61-802, Laws of Florida; provides for distribution of race track funds for certain counties.
- 5) Chapter 75-46, Laws of Florida 1975; created a new Section to Chapter 550, Florida Statutes; provides for increase of monies withheld from pools on harness horse racing for purposes of providing funds for daily operational expenses of said tracks.
- 6) Chapter 75-241, Laws of Florida 1975; added 550.41(7) Florida Statutes; summer thoroughbred horse racing; one additional day; funds to Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation.
- 7) Chapter 75-44, Laws of Florida 1975; established Joint Interim Legislative and Executive Study Committee; study feasiability of creating Horse Racing Trust.
- 8) Chapter 75-45, Laws of Florida 1975; amended 550.12, Florida Statutes; to provide uniform reporting system for uniform operational and financial data by associations, and provides for appraisal of all associations.

LITIGATION

During the fiscal year ending June 30, 1975, the Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering was party to the following litigation:

- 1. W. F. Caple vs. Division of PMW-Dade County Circuit Court, Complaint for a temporary restraining order and an attack on the validity of Rule 7E-1.06(15) and (16) prohibiting any person from having any hypodermic syringe or hypodermic needle within a licensed establishment and requires that all medicines or drugs shall be kept or stored at all times in a securely locked cabinet. Case is still pending.
- 2. W. F. Caple vs. Division of PMW-Board Appeal, appealing the Order of the Director of the Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering suspending the license of W. F. Caple for violation of Rule 7E-1.06(15) and (16). Board affirmed Division.
- 3. Martin Tabak vs. Orange Park Kennel Club and the State of Florida—Clay County Circuit Court, Mr. Tabak is attempting to re-establish a lost winning pari-mutuel ticket. Circuit Court re-established ticket. Division did not appeal.
- 4. Ike Bailey vs. Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering and Theodore T. Zornow, President of the U.S. Trotting Association—Federal District Court (Northern District), Attacking Division's refusal to issue a license to Ike Bailey based on rule which requires that the applicant must hold a current license with the United States Trotting Association. Suit still pending.
- 5. Kenneth D. Wilkey vs. Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering—Board Appeal, Wilkey appealed an order of the Director of the Division suspending his license for two years to the Board. The Board affirmed the Director's order, but reduced the suspension to one year. Such case resulted from having found a horse owned and trained by Wilkey raced with a medication in its system.
- 6. Kenneth D. Wilkey vs. Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering—First District Court of Appeal, Appealing the order of the Board suspending Mr. Wilkey's trainer's license for one year. (see above). First District Court of Appeal affirmed Division Director and Board, but remanded case to Board to reduce penalty. Board reduced penalty to ten months.
- 7. Volusia Jai-Alai vs. Division of PMW-First District Court of Appeal, appealing an order of the Director suspending the license and permit of Volusia Jai-Alai, Inc., and Sports Palace, Inc. where Emprise Corporation had an interest in both plants and had been convicted of a felony.
- 8. Gator Downs Racing, Inc. vs. Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering—Board Appeal, attacking Division's adoption of a rule limiting the number of trifectas run in one day to one. Case settled and voluntarily dismissed.
- Tourist Attractions, Inc. vs. Division of PMW—Board Appeal, attacking Division's adoption of a rule limiting the number of trifectas run in one day to one. Case settled and voluntarily dismissed.
- 10. Biscayne Kennel Club vs. Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering—Board Appeal, attacking Division's adoption of a rule limiting the number of trifectas run in one day to one. Case settled and voluntarily dismissed.
- 11. Lenny D. Jeffries vs. Division of PMW-Board Appeal, appealing an order of the Director revoking his license. Board affirmed Director's Order, but reduced revocation to a 60-day suspension.

- 12. West Flagler Association vs. Jack B. Cooper—Circuit Court, requesting an interpretation of §550.188, F.S., and attacking its validity. Circuit Court declared statute unconstitutional. Division did not appeal.
- 13. Joseph G. Wiseman vs. Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering—Board Appeal, appealing an adverse decision of the Director to the Board. Case dismissed.
- 14. Daytona Beach Kennel Club vs. Division of PMW—Board Appeal, Appealing an order of the Director suspending Daytona's permit and license due to its affiliation with Emprise Corporation which has been convicted of a felony. Case dismissed by Board as a result of a Court decision.
- 15. Patsy Passero vs. Division of PMW-Board Appeal, appealing an adverse decision of the Director to the Board. Subject did not perfect his appeal. Case dismissed.
- 16. Joe Ringler vs. Division of PMW-Board Appeal, appealing an adverse decision of the Director to the Board. Subject ejected as patron for tenpercenting tickets. Case pending.
- 17. Clyde St. Leon vs. Division of PMW-Board Appeal, appealing an adverse decision of the Director to the Board. Motion to dismiss granted. No response from appelee. Case dismissed.
- 18. Latin American Jai-Alai, Inc. vs. Division of PMW-Board Appeal, appealing an order of the Director refusing to grant a permit or license to Latin American Jai-Alai because said fronton would be within a fifty mile radius of another fronton. Director's order affirmed.
- 19. Billy Rose vs. Division of PMW-Board Appeal, appealing an adverse decision of the Director to the Board. Case voluntarily dismissed.
- 20. Churruca, et al. vs. Board of Business Regulation, et al.—Federal District Court, Southern District of Florida, #72-2045-Civ-JLK, Sixteen former jai-alai players filed an action against the Board and many of the jai-alai frontons arising out of a dispute between the jai-alai frontons and the jai-alai players and a ruling by the former Racing Commission during the 1968-69 season. The Plaintiffs allege that the jai-alai fronton violated the Sherman and Clayton Acts in refusing employment to the jai-alai players, and further allege that the former Racing Commission conspired with these Defendant jai-alai frontons to violate such act. The suit is for triple damages and is in excess of \$300,000. Case dismissed.
- 21. Churruca, et al. vs. Board of Business Regulation, et al.—Circuit Court, Dade County, (same as above). Case dismissed by Court.
- 22. Churruca, et al. vs. Board of Business Regulation, et al.—Third District Court of Appeal, (same as above). Churruca appealed decision of Dade County Circuit Court dismissing suit. Appeal pending.
- 23. Investment Corp. of South Florida, vs. J. P. McCann-Circuit Court, Dade County, attacking the validity of Division's amendment to trifecta rule which limited the number of trifectas run in one day to one. Case voluntarily dismissed.
- 24. Investment Corp. of South Florida vs. J. P. McCann and Board of Business Regulation—Cir. Ct., Dade County—attacking the validity of Division's Uniform Reporting Rule. Rule declared invalid by Circuit Court.
- 25. J. Patrick McCann and Board of Business Regulation vs. Investment Corp. of South Florida—Third District Court of Appeal, Division appealing order of Circuit Court declaring Uniform Reporting Rule invalid. Appeal pending.

- 26. General Sales Drivers and Allied Employers Union Local No. 198 vs. Dania Jai-Alai Palace, Inc. and Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering—Circuit Court, Broward County, attacking Division's authority to require 15 days notice prior to commencement of a strike and requests damages. Suit pending.
- 27. Gulfstream Park Racing Association vs. Division of PMW-Third District Court of Appeal, attacking the authority of the Director of the Division of PMW to waive a rule. Appeal voluntarily dismissed.
- 28. Jefferson County Kennel Club and Division of PMW vs. Kennel Owners, JCKC—Cir. Ct. and First District Court of Appeal, seeking mandatory injunction to order kennel owners back to tracks. Injunction issued. Case subsequently settled. Kennel owners returned to track.
- 29. W. F. Caple vs. Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering—Third District Court of Appeal, attacking order of Division Director as affirmed by Board of Business Regulation, which had suspended trainer's license for having allowed a hypodermic syringe and needle to be in his tack room and for having allowed a medicine or drug to be left on the premises without being locked in a cabinet. Case pending.
- 30. Gulfstream Park Racing Ass'n. vs. Board of Business Regulation—First District Court of Appeal, attacking Board's allocation of racing dates for the three South Florida thoroughbred tracks. Case pending.
- 31. Daytona Beach Kennel Club and Division of PMW vs. Kennel Owners of DBKC—Circuit Court and First District Court of Appeal, seeking mandatory injunction to order kennel owners back to DBKC. Preliminary injunction denied. Case settled. Kennel owners returned to track.
- 32. Charles DiRocco vs. Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering—Circuit Court, Seminole County, attempting to enjoin Division from suspending an occupational license of a Public Relations expert. Case voluntarily dismissed.
- 33. Alderson vs. Division of PMW-Circuit Court, Pinellas County, attempting to have a lost winning pari-mutuel ticket re-established. Suit pending.
- 34. Florida Gaming, Inc. vs. State of Florida, et al.—United States District Court, attempting to establish that pari-mutuel laws allow gambling casinos in the State of Florida without further legislation. Case pending.
- 35. W. F. Caple vs. Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering—Board Appeal, trainer appealing order fining him \$200 and redistributing for horse having unauthorized bute in system after running of a race. Case pending.
- 36. Nathan H. Kelly vs. Pari-Mutuel Wagering—Board Appeal, horse owner appealing order of Director suspending owner's license for 60 days for financial irresponsibility. Director's order affirmed by Board of Business Regulation.
- 37. Ruben Hernandez vs. Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering—Board Appeal, jockey appealing order of Director suspending his license for three days for careless riding, Board affirmed Director's order.
- 38. Henry Perle vs. Division of PMW-Board Appeal, appealing order of Director declaring Perle ineligible for reinstatement as a patron for having cashed a ticket for another. (ten percenting). Case pending.
- 39. Marion Bragg vs. Division of PMW-Board Appeal, appealing order of Director finding Bragg ineligible to be reinstated as a patron for having offered to cash tickets for other persons (ten percenting). Case pending.

- 40. Edmond R. Wells vs. Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering—Board Appeal, appealing order of Director declaring Wells ineligible to be a patron as being an undesirable and having conducted himself in such a manner as to disturb the peace and make himself obnoxious. Case pending.
- 41. Paul Powell vs. Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering—Board Appeal, appealing order of Director finding horse trainer had failed to show proper protection in the guarding of a horse under his care found to have an unauthorized medication in his system. Case pending.
- 42. Solomon Maragle vs. Division of PMW—Board Appeal, appealing order of Division Director revoking license for having carried and fired a deadly weapon on a licensed premises. Case pending.
- 43. Edward Celestine vs. Division of PMW—Board Appeal, appealing order of Director revoking a hot walker's license because of a narcotic conviction and for falsification of his license application. Case pending.
- 44. Daniel J. Harbeck vs. Division of PMW—Board Appeal, appealing adverse decision of Division Director, in that subject had falsified his license application by failing to disclose narcotic conviction. Case pending.

NATIONAL COORDINATION

The State of Florida is a member of the National Assocation of State Racing Commissioners (NASRC), an organization made up of all of the various states having legalized pari-mutuel activities. Through the exchange of information and ideas, the National Association is of great benefit to each member of the association. Under a reciprocity agreement, each state recognizes rulings made by another state racing board.

The 1975 Convention was held March 16-21, 1975 in New Orleans, where the NASRC enjoyed the outstanding hospitality of the Louisiana State Racing Commission.

The Association of Official Racing Chemists also held their convention in New Orleans in conjunction with the National Association of State Racing Commissioners.

The Division actively participates in meetings and conferences held by the NASRC regionally, and the Director is a member of the Executive Committee of the NASRC.

During the past fiscal year Florida went on line on the National Association of State Racing Information System (NASRIS). This permits the State of Florida to check a central computer located in Lexington, Kentucky, containing a record of all rulings issued against persons participating in racing in North America and data on their licensing status. This has been and will continue to be of invaluable assistance in excluding undesirables from racing.

CONCLUSION

In behalf of my employees and myself, please be assured that this Division shall continue to dedicate itself to the best interests of the public and the State of Florida by seeing that pari-mutuel activities are conducted with complete integrity.




