Dear Governor Graham:

The Florida Pari-Mutuel Commission and the Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering respectfully submit their Fifty-third Annual Report for the period beginning July 1, 1983 and ending June 30, 1984, in compliance with the requirements of Chapters 20.16 (4)(d) and 550.02 (2), Florida Statutes. The Annual Report presents an accurate record of the activities of the Division and the pari-mutuel industry during the fiscal year. The records, files and documents from which the Report is compiled are maintained at the Division office in the State Office Building, 1350 Northwest 12 Avenue, Room 332, Miami, Florida 33136-2169. These records are open for inspection to all persons during regular business hours.

The Pari-Mutuel Commission has the legislative authority and responsibility for awarding racing dates; hearing appeals of all decisions which relate to the suspension or revocation of a permittee's license; making recommendations to the Division regarding new or existing rules for all racing and jai-alai operations; approving all expenditures of the permittee's special capital improvement funds; and issuing an annual report to the Governor and Legislature on the racing and jai-alai industries in Florida. During this period Mr. Stephen Abramson of West Palm Beach continued to serve as chairman of the Florida Pari-Mutuel Commission. Dr. Leon van Wert served as vice-chairman. Messrs. Theodore J. Couch, James Lewis and Billy Vessels served as members.

The Commission faced a particularly difficult issue this year when their authority to award the lucrative thoroughbred middle racing dates was struck down by the Fourth District Court of Appeals in *Hialeah Park, Inc. vs Gulfstream Park Racing Association, Inc.* in March of 1983, Case Nos. 82-703 and 82-946. In August of 1983, the Third District Court of Appeals issued a conflicting opinion in *Gulfstream Park Racing Association, Inc. vs. Department of Business Regulation*. The Supreme Court attempted to resolve the issue in December of 1983, when it issued an opinion agreeing with the Third District Court of Appeals' ruling that the Commission did, indeed, have the authority to award racing dates, and set down criteria for its decision (*Gulfstream Park Racing Association, Inc. vs. Department of Business Regulation*). Based upon those criteria, the Commission awarded the middle dates to Gulfstream Park Racing Association, Inc. However, the Third District Court of Appeals reversed that decision when it ordered the Commission to award the dates to Hialeah Park in *Hialeah Park, Inc. vs. Department of Business Regulation*. Hialeah proceeded to operate the middle dates. After the fact, the

Supreme Court ruled that the Third District Court of Appeals had acted improperly and reaffirmed the Commission's authority to award racing dates in *Gulfstream Park Racing Association, Inc. vs. Department of Business Regulation*, Case Nos. 64-186 and 64-257. It is our belief that this ruling substantially clarifies issues surrounding the awarding of winter thoroughbred racing dates.

Also, Commission member Billy Vessels was elected President of the National Association of Racing Commissioners and Chairman Stephen Abramson was elected to the office of third vice-president, enhancing Florida's active role on a national level.

The Division underwent a change in leadership this year when Division Director Robert M. Smith, Jr. resigned to return to the private sector. Mr. Robert M. Rosenberg, then Deputy Director, was appointed Director in February of this year. The Division wishes to express its gratitude to Mr. Smith for his service. Under both Mr. Rosenberg's and Mr. Smith's leadership, the Division had a very active year; of the 39 existing permits, 38 operated at Florida's 33 pari-mutuel facilities. *Gulfstream Park Racing Association, Inc.* did not activate its quarter horse racing permit. No new permits were approved.

Detailed statistical analyses of each of the tracks and frontons which operated during the 1983-84 fiscal year are included in the exhibits of this report.

The industry continued to show healthy signs of growth this year, despite a slight decrease in attendance of 1.82% to 16,692,861. However, in 5,053 regular performances, \$1,824,552,088 was wagered, an increase of 4.01%. In addition, 126 charity day performances resulted in a minimum of \$1,719,026.83 being donated to approved charitable organizations (see exhibit L). Chapter 550.164, Florida Statutes, requires that abandoned pari-mutuel tickets over one year old from Greyhound and Jai-Alai permitholders should escheat to the State for deposit to the Principal of the State School fund. These funds are used for the support and maintenance of our public schools. A total of \$2,644,804.10 was received from this source by the Division throughout this fiscal year. Chart I shows yearly receipts dating from 1957, when the Division began collecting these funds. Pursuant to Chapter 550.263 (2) Florida Statutes, funds from abandoned tickets for all Thoroughbred, Harness, and Quarter Horse racing events are deposited to their respective Promotional Trust Funds for payments of breeders' and stallions' awards.

Permittees may choose to operate charity days on behalf of the Scholarship Trust Fund, created for the purpose of providing scholarships for qualified applicants. The fund is administered by the State Board of Regents. A total of \$172,776.44 was deposited to the Scholarship Trust Fund in the past fiscal year. (See Chart II).

Growth in the pari-mutuel industry in Florida resulted in increases in revenue to the State as well. The sum of \$120,130,753.69 was collected from all sources by the Division this fiscal year. Of this amount, \$4,823,206.59 was expended in regulating the operations of the entire industry. \$29,915,500 was distributed to 67 counties, each county receiving \$446,500. Deposits to the General Revenue Fund totaled \$53,925,050.58 to provide substantial support to the varied functions of State Government. Fines from medication rule violations are deposited to the Racing Research Trust Fund. A total of \$9,540.00 was collected during the fiscal year for this purpose.

The Division continued in its efforts to effectively enforce the medication statutes and rules. Towards this end, the Bureau of Laboratory Services performed 149,586 analyses of 53,668 samples resulting in 116 reports of illegal drugs. The positives were then referred to the Division Director for appropriate regulatory and legal action. At the same time, the Bureau utilizes its legislative appropriations and funds from the Racing Research Trust Fund to participate in the National Association of State Racing Commissioners' quality assurance program and certain research from the University of Florida.

In addition to reporting positives, the laboratory informs the Division Director of tracks where multiple suspicious or unidentifiable substances appear in samples. He may then direct the Bureau of Investigations to confirm the existence of illegal substances so that administrative action can be taken. This has proven to be helpful in the control of illegal drugging. In combination, these methods resulting in multiple license suspensions during this year's Pompano Park Quarter Horse meet.

The Bureau of Investigations has also dedicated substantial manpower to license falsification issues in a continuing effort to prevent ineligible applicants from becoming licensed. On a larger scale, the Bureau performed extensive background investigations of individuals who wished to purchase significant interests in pari-mutuel associations.

The problem of computer fraud is a source of concern to the industry and the Division. The Division played a significant role in several such investigations which resulted in convictions for grand theft and computer fraud. This is an area in which the Division hopes to devote substantial resources.

Legislation which should have a favorable impact upon the performance and regulation of the pari-mutuel wagering industry in Florida was passed during the 1984 legislative session. In particular, additional days were approved for Pensacola Kennel Club and the Harness racing season, purses and owners awards were increased through tax structure revisions, and simulcasting of out-of-state pari-mutuel events were approved. Also, the Division received enhanced authority in

licensing and patron exclusion matters, and totalisator companies will be required to post surety bonds or other proof of financial responsibility, in a move which should substantially protect State revenues by assessing strict liability in case of revenues lost due to computer failure.

In conclusion, the Division Director and his staff appreciate the continued support and cooperation which has been received from members of the Legislature and their staffs. The Division is deeply indebted to Governor Bob Graham for his continued and renewed interest and support of the State's vital pari-mutuel industry. In addition, the Division expresses its thanks to Secretary Gary R. Rutledge and the Commission for their continued support in the Division's efforts to more capably and fairly regulate the State's pari-mutuel industry.
