### FINAL ORDER

The Department of Business and Professional Regulation, Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering ("Petitioner" or "Division"), hereby enters this Final Order against Elvecius Moriceau ("Respondent"), and states as follows:

- 1. An Administrative Complaint was filed in this case on November 21, 2018, alleging that Respondent violated provisions of section 550.0251(6), Florida Statutes ("Administrative Complaint"). A true and correct copy of the Administrative Complaint is attached hereto as Exhibit "1" and incorporated by reference.
- 2. Service of the Administrative Complaint was attempted via certified mail on Respondent. Proof of attempted service via certified mail is attached hereto as Exhibit "2" and incorporated by reference.
- 3. Notice of this matter was served upon Respondent on March 1, 2019, March 8, 2019, March 15, 2019 and March 22, 2019, via publication in the Broward Daily Business Review, a publication in general circulation within Boward County, Florida ("Notice of Action").

A true and correct copy of the Notice of Action is attached hereto as Exhibit "3" and incorporated by reference.

- 4. The Notice of Action Election informed Respondent that Petitioner filed an Administrative Complaint against him and provided instructions on how to receive a copy of the Administrative Complaint and that contact would be required to dispute the allegations within the Administrative Complaint. See § 120.569(1), Fla. Stat. and Fla. Admin. Code R. 28-106.111.
- 5. In addition, the Notice of Action informed Respondent that the failure to timely file a response to the Administrative Complaint would be deemed a waiver of right to a hearing or resolution in this matter.
- 6. To date, Respondent has not submitted an Election of Rights form or otherwise provided a response to the Administrative Complaint filed and served in this action.

Upon consideration of the facts and conclusions of law delineated in the Administrative Complaint, it is ORDERED:

- 7. The allegations of fact set forth in the Administrative Complaint are approved, adopted and incorporated herein by reference as findings of fact by the Division.
- 8. The conclusions of law alleged and set forth in the Administrative Complaint are approved, adopted, and incorporated herein by references as the conclusions of law by the Division.
- 9. There is competent substantial evidence to support the findings of fact and conclusions of law by the Division.

- 10. Respondent's is hereby PERMANENTLY EXCLUDED from all pari-mutuel facilities in the state of Florida.

### ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT

The Department of Business and Professional Regulation, Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering (Petitioner) files this Administrative Complaint against Elvecius Moriceau (Respondent), and alleges:

- 1. Petitioner is the state agency charged with regulating pari-mutuel wagering and cardroom operations pursuant to chapter 550 and section 849.086, Florida Statutes.
- 2. At all times material hereto, Respondent did not hold a valid pari-mutuel wagering license with the Petitioner.
- 3. Casino Dania Beach is a licensed pari-mutuel and cardroom facility in the state of Florida.
  - At all times material hereto, Respondent was a patron at Casino Dania Beach. 4.
- 5. On or about October 22, 2018, Respondent was ejected by Casino Dania Beach security officers and local sheriff's deputies for aggressive conduct directed toward Casino Dania Beach cardroom employees.

- 6. On or about October 22, 2018, Respondent was issued a trespass warning and lifetime ejection by Casino Dania Beach.
  - 7. Pursuant to section 550.0251(6), Florida Statutes:

In addition to the power to exclude certain persons from any parimutuel facility in this state, the division may exclude any person from any and all pari-mutuel facilities in this state for conduct that would constitute, if the person were a licensee, a violation of this chapter or the rules of the division. The division may exclude from any pari-mutuel facility within this state any person who has been ejected from a pari-mutuel facility in this state or who has been excluded from any pari-mutuel facility in another state by the governmental department, agency, commission, or authority exercising regulatory jurisdiction over pari-mutuel facilities in such other state.

8. Based on the foregoing, Respondent is subject to exclusion from all pari-mutuel wagering facilities in the state of Florida by virtue of Respondent's permanent exclusion from Casino Dania Beach on October 22, 2018.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests the Division enter an Order permanently EXCLUDING Respondent from all licensed pari-mutuel facilities in the state pursuant to chapter 550, Florida Statutes, and the rules promulgated thereunder.
