FINAL ORDER

This matter appeared before the Florida Gaming Control Commission at a duly-noticed public meeting on May 2, 2023, for final agency action pursuant to sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes. After a complete review of the record in this matter, the Commission makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law:

1. An Administrative Complaint was filed in this case on March 9, 2023, alleging that Respondent is subject to exclusion from all licensed pari-mutuel facilities and all facilities of a slot machine licensee in the state of Florida under sections 550.0251(6) and 551.112, Florida Statutes. A copy of the Administrative Complaint is attached hereto as Exhibit "1" and incorporated by reference.

2. The Administrative Complaint, Election of Rights form, an Explanation of Rights, and a cover letter were served on Respondent via certified mail on March 22, 2023. Proof of service is attached hereto as Exhibit "2" and incorporated by reference.

3. The Election of Rights form, Explanation of Rights, and cover letter informed Respondent that a written response to the Administrative Complaint, including the right to request

a hearing, was due within 21 days of actual service of the Administrative Complaint. *See* § 120.569(1), Fla. Stat., and Fla. Admin. Code. R. 28-106.111.

4. Petitioner informed Respondent that the failure to file a timely response to the Administrative Complaint would be deemed a waiver of the right to a hearing.

5. Respondent has not filed a timely response to the Administrative Complaint. Respondent has not submitted any evidence or made any allegations that would support the application of the doctrine of equitable tolling.

Having considered the Administrative Complaint, the service of the Administrative Complaint with Election of Rights form, Explanation of Rights, and cover letter on Respondent along with Respondent's failure to respond, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, it is hereby

ORDERED and ADJUDGED:


6. The allegations of fact and the conclusions of law in the Administrative Complaint are adopted in their entirety herein.

7. Respondent is hereby **PERMANENTLY EXCLUDED** from all pari-mutuel facilities and all facilities of a slot machine licensee within the State of Florida.

This Final Order shall take effect upon being filed with the Clerk of the Commission.

ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT

The Florida Gaming Control Commission, Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering (“Petitioner”), files this Administrative Complaint against Bradley Taylor Hooper (“Respondent”), and alleges:

1. Petitioner is the state agency charged with regulating pari-mutuel wagering, slot machines, and cardroom operations pursuant to chapters 550, 551, and 849, Florida Statutes.
2. At all times material hereto, Respondent’s address was reported as 805 Southwest 8th Avenue Dania, Florida 33004.
3. At all times material hereto, the Casino at Dania Beach was a facility operated by a permitholder authorized to conduct pari-mutuel wagering, slot machines, and cardroom operations in the state of Florida.
4. On or about February 13, 2023, Respondent was a patron of the Casino at Dania Beach.
5. On or about February 13, 2023, Respondent was ejected and permanently excluded from the Casino at Dania Beach.



6. Respondent was permanently excluded for the reasons alleged in Exhibit 1.

7. Section 550.0251(6), Florida Statutes, provides in relevant part:

In addition to the power to exclude certain persons from any pari-mutuel facility in this state, the commission may exclude any person from any and all pari-mutuel facilities in this state for conduct that would constitute, if the person were a licensee, a violation of this chapter or the rules of the commission. The commission may exclude from any pari-mutuel facility within this state any person who has been ejected from a pari-mutuel facility in this state or who has been excluded from any pari-mutuel facility in another state by the governmental department, agency, commission, or authority exercising regulatory jurisdiction over pari-mutuel facilities in such other state.

(Emphasis supplied).

8. Section 551.112, Florida Statutes, provides:

In addition to the power to exclude certain persons from any facility of a slot machine licensee in this state, the commission may exclude any person from any facility of a slot machine licensee in this state for conduct that would constitute, if the person were a licensee, a violation of this chapter or the rules of the commission. The commission may exclude from any facility of a slot machine licensee any person who has been ejected from a facility of a slot machine licensee in this state or who has been excluded from any facility of a slot machine licensee or gaming facility in another state by the governmental department, agency, commission, or authority exercising regulatory jurisdiction over the gaming in such other state. This section does not abrogate the common law right of a slot machine licensee to exclude a patron absolutely in this state.

(Emphasis supplied).

9. Based on the foregoing, Respondent is subject to exclusion from all licensed pari-mutuel wagering facilities and any facility of a slot machine licensee in the state of Florida under sections 550.0251(6) and 551.112, Florida Statutes based on his ejection from the Casino at Dania Beach on or about February 13, 2023.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests the Florida Gaming Control Commission enter an Order excluding Respondent from all licensed pari-mutuel wagering facilities and any facility of a slot machine licensee in the state of Florida, along with any other remedy provided by chapters 550 and 551, Florida Statutes, and/or the rules promulgated thereunder.

Mediation under section 120.573, Florida Statutes, is not available to resolve this Administrative Complaint.




CONTINUATION

The CDB Surveillance and Security Reports (EXHIBIT #1) related to Bradley Taylor HOOPER describe in detail the activity which eventually led to his arrest by the Broward County Sheriff's Office (BSO). In summary, HOOPER (for reasons unknown) believed that he was due \$20.00 from CDB Kiosk #1. This is an automated machine from which patrons can redeem slot tickets or break bill denominations. For an extended period of time on the evening of February 13, 2023, HOOPER attempted several different strategies to extract the perceived \$20.00 bill from the kiosk. In doing so he attempted to insert a number of objects into the orifices of the kiosk. As his effort escalated, one implement he used in his activity was subsequently identified as a "barbecue grill igniter." His actions ultimately caused significant damage to the machine.

As this saga unfolded HOOPER became confrontational with CDB Security Personnel and BSO Deputies (as noted in the CDB Security Report) were called to the scene; HOOPER was subsequently arrested. This Investigator reviewed the related surveillance recording and confirmed all noted actions (EXHIBIT #3). I noted on video as HOOPER was being placed in a BSO vehicle, the presence of an apparent ankle monitoring device¹. I was advised that once inside the BSO vehicle, HOOPER promptly went to sleep. In interviewing CDB Security Personnel, their impression was that HOOPER'S irrational behavior may have been due to him being impaired. Incidentally, when an attendant was called to inspect the machine, the alleged \$20.00 bill was not found.

Conclusion: As a result of his vandalism and aggression, CDB lifetime excluded HOOPER (EXHIBIT #2) and will be pressing charges for the damage done to the kiosk. HOOPER should be considered for exclusion from all pari-mutuel facilities in the state of Florida.

Status: Case closed by Investigations and forwarded to Legal for review.

¹ *Comprehensive Case Information System (CCIS) records reveal that HOOPER has an extensive arrest history which includes multiple instances of Grand Theft, Burglary and Narcotics Possession. In fact HOOPER has three separate felony cases which are currently pending (EXHIBIT #4).*

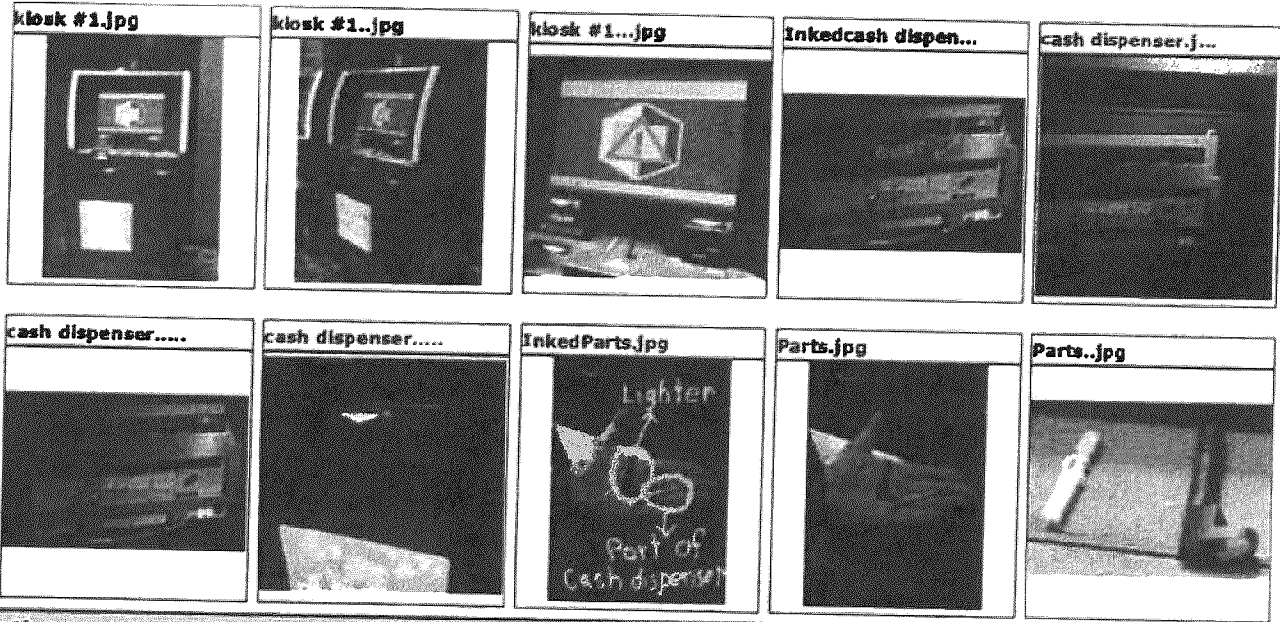

On Monday February 13, 2023 at approximately 8:00pm, security agent Chad Culmer requested the presence of a security supervisor to the south valet security post where he was located at the time. Security Supervisor Adewale Adesuyi arrived on the scene and made contact with Culmer, who in turn advised Adesuyi of a suspicious activity taking place at kiosk #1. Adesuyi proceeds to kiosk #1, then arrives there to observe a white male patron later identified as Bradley Taylor Hooper, digging a barbecue grill ignitor in the cash dispenser slot, while down on his knees. Adesuyi noticed a burning odor coming from the kiosk. Adesuyi asked Mr. Hooper why he was digging an object in the cash dispenser, to which he responded by stating, "I'm trying to get my \$20 dollar bill that is stuck in there". Cash Control Supervisor Jorge Ramos was contacted and requested to respond on the scene in order to assist with checking to see if there was in fact money stuck in there. Ramos arrived on the scene, then opened the kiosk and noticed a piece of a barbecue grill ignitor, along with a part from the cash dispenser on the floor inside the kiosk. He also noticed a burnt stain on a metal part of the cash dispenser. There was no loose cash to be found in there at all. Mr. Hooper was repeatedly told by Adesuyi to stop sticking objects in the cash dispenser to which he responded in an aggressive manner towards Adesuyi with words full of profanity following and as he moved in close proximity to him. Adesuyi contacted the security command post, so that Broward Sherriff Officers could come on property for assistance. Two BSO Officers arrived on property via the south valet entrance, then came to kiosk #01, where Adesuyi and Mr. Hooper stood. BSO and Adesuyi went to the video review room as part of an investigation to see what transpired with Mr. Hooper and the casino's kiosk #01. The review revealed that at approximately 7:44pm, Mr. Hooper was sticking what appeared to be a card and a barbecue grill ignitor in the kiosk cash dispenser numerous times until Adesuyi approached him at approximately 8:03pm, which was around 19 minutes before Adesuyi made contact with him. A nearby female guest, who smelled something burning, then alerted Culmer of the suspicious activity. Due to Mr. Hooper's action, Adesuyi made it clear to BSO and Hooper that he is now being permanently banned from the casino. BSO placed Mr. Hooper under arrest, then escorted him to their vehicles which was parked outside the south valet entrance. Adesuyi advised BSO that due to nature of the crime Mr. Hooper willingly acted upon against private property, we will be pressing charges against him. All relevant data related to this

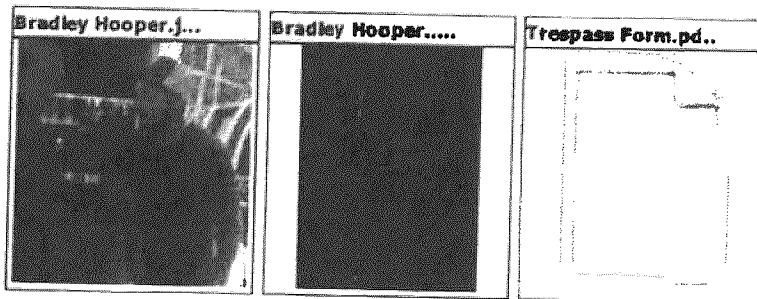

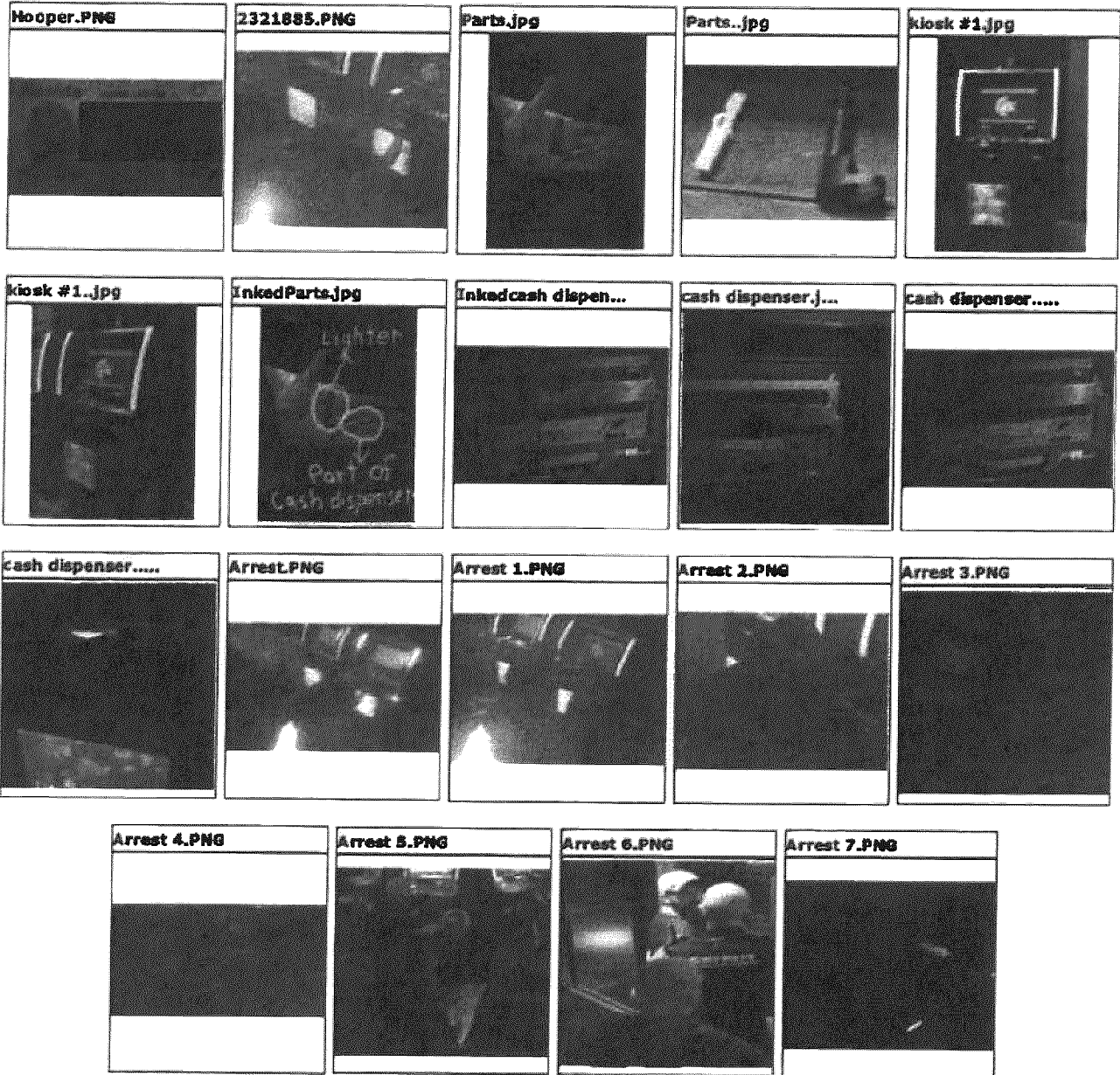

On February 13th, 2023, at 20:03 hrs, Surveillance was notified by Security Supervisor Adewale Adesuyi of a W/M, later identified as Bradley Taylor Hooper(PC # 6670742). Hooper had told Adesuyi he lost \$20 inside Kiosk #1. After reviewing the video, Adesuyi, Cage Supervisor Jorge Ramos, and Broward Sheriff Deputy declared Hooper had tampered with Kiosk #1 and caused damage to the machine. Hooper was observed inserting a card, money, voucher, and pen-like object inside the cash dispenser part of the Kiosk. Broward Sheriff Deputies conducted an arrest on Hooper and escorted him out of the Valet Entrance and into their vehicles.

The video revealed the following:

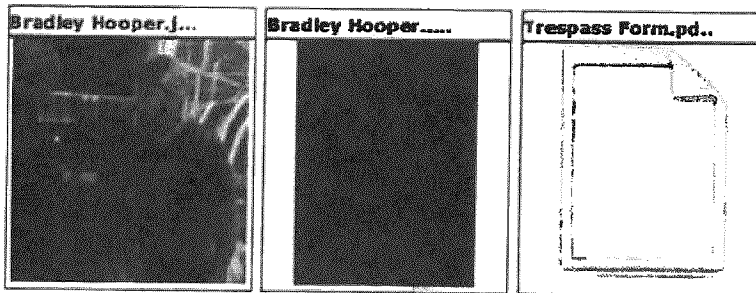
- At 19:44:29 hrs, Hooper approached Kiosk #1, trying to place a card inside the cash dispenser area.
- At 19:44:57 hrs, Guest Floor Attendant Tracey Flock began helping Hooper at Kiosk #1.
- At 19:45:27 hrs, Hooper tried placing his card inside the cash dispenser area.
- At 19:48:15 hrs, Hooper inserted two vouchers into Kiosk #1.
- At 19:48:39 hrs, Hooper takes the voucher from Kiosk #1.
- At 19:51:01 hrs, Hooper placed two unknown bills into Kiosk #1.
- At 19:52:41 hrs, Hooper is stuffing his fingers inside the Kiosk dispenser area.
- At 19:51:57 hrs, the Kiosk screen shows out of service while Hooper tampering with the cash dispenser area.
- At 19:58:14 hrs, While still using his card on the dispenser area of the machine, Hooper took out a pen-like object and started using it on the Kiosk.
- At 20:03:23 hrs, Adesuyi arrived at Kiosk #1 and began speaking with Hooper. Hooper immediately stopped messing with the Kiosk.
- At 20:08:33 hrs, Ramos arrived at Kiosk #1 and began speaking with both Adesuyi and Hooper.
- At 20:14:51 hrs, Ramos advised opening Kiosk #1.
- At 20:17:28 hrs, Two Broward Sheriff Deputies arrived at Kiosk #1.
- At 20:55:40 hrs, Deputies placed Hooper under arrest.
- At 20:59:27 hrs, Hooper and the Deputies exit the Valet entrance.
- At 21:04:59 hrs, Hooper was placed inside the Deputies vehicle.
- At 22:24:52 hrs, Deputies and Hooper exit the property via Valet.

On February 13th, 2023, at 20:37 hrs, Ramos, Adesuyi, and Broward Sheriff Deputy reviewed the video inside the review room.

On February 13th, 2023, at 21:41 hrs, Broward Sheriff Detective and Adesuyi reviewed the video inside the review room.

Subject: SR - 21885 - Arrest on Property - Bradley Taylor Hooper tampered with Kiosk #1

On February 13th, 2023, at 20:03 hrs, Surveillance was notified by Security Supervisor Adewale Adesuyi of a W/M, later identified as Bradley Taylor Hooper(PC # 6670742). Hooper had told Adesuyi he lost \$20 inside Kiosk #1. After reviewing the video, Adesuyi, Cage Supervisor Jorge Ramos, and Broward Sheriff Deputy declared Hooper had tampered with Kiosk #1 and caused damage to the machine. Hooper was observed inserting a card, money, voucher, and pen-like object inside the cash dispenser part of the Kiosk. Broward Sheriff Deputies conducted an arrest on Hooper and escorted him out of the Valet Entrance and into their vehicles.

The video revealed the following:

- At 19:44:29 hrs, Hooper approached Kiosk #1, trying to place a card inside the cash dispenser area.
- At 19:44:57 hrs, Guest Floor Attendant Tracey Flock began helping Hooper at Kiosk #1.
- At 19:45:27 hrs, Hooper tried placing his card inside the cash dispenser area.
- At 19:48:15 hrs, Hooper inserted two vouchers into Kiosk #1.
- At 19:48:39 hrs, Hooper takes the voucher from Kiosk #1.
- At 19:51:01 hrs, Hooper placed two unknown bills into Kiosk #1.

- At 19:51:57 hrs, the Kiosk screen shows out of service while Hooper tampering with the cash dispenser area.
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- At 20:03:23 hrs, Adesuyi arrived at Kiosk #1 and began speaking with Hooper. Hooper immediately stopped messing with the Kiosk.
- At 20:08:33 hrs, Ramos arrived at Kiosk #1 and began speaking with both Adesuyi and Hooper.
- At 20:14:51 hrs, Ramos advised opening Kiosk #1.
- At 20:17:28 hrs, Two Broward Sheriff Deputies arrived at Kiosk #1.
- At 20:55:40 hrs, Deputies placed Hooper under arrest.
- At 20:59:27 hrs, Hooper and the Deputies exit the Valet entrance.
- At 21:04:59 hrs, Hooper was placed inside the Deputies vehicle.
- At 22:24:52 hrs, Deputies and Hooper exit the property via Valet.
