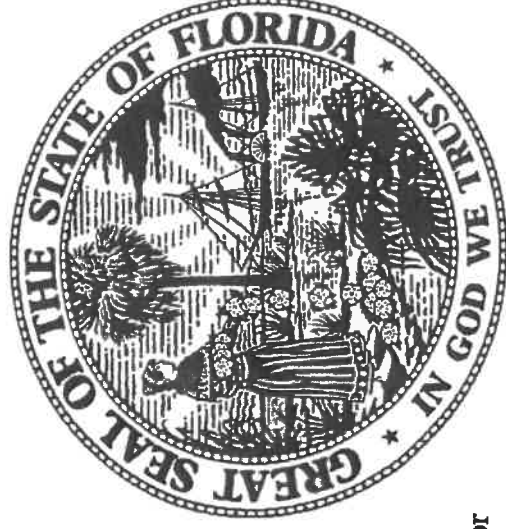

bestbet Jacksonville, Inc. d/b/a bestbet, bestbet Jacksonville, and/or Jacksonville Kennel Club ("bestbet Jacksonville") possesses a greyhound permit. bestbet Jacksonville has been issued a part-mutuel operating license and a cardroom license for the 2022-2023 Fiscal Year. bestbet Jacksonville is currently licensed to operate 88 card tables and is requesting permission to add 4 more to its cardroom. bestbet Jacksonville has paid the \$4,000 license fee associated with the additional tables.

The Commission has received and reviewed the pertinent records and supporting documentation concerning bestbet Jacksonville's amended application for a cardroom license and after proper consideration thereof,
