FINAL ORDER APPROVING AMENDMENT TO CARDROOM LICENSE

Pursuant to the provisions of section 849.086, Florida Statutes, and the rules promulgated thereunder, the Florida Gaming Control Commission (“Commission”) is responsible for the investigation and prior approval of applications and amendments to applications for cardrooms; and

Fronton Holdings, LLC d/b/a Casino Fort Pierce (“Casino Fort Pierce”) possesses a jai alai permit. Casino Fort Pierce has been issued a pari-mutuel operating license and a cardroom license for the 2022-2023 Fiscal Year. Casino Fort Pierce is currently licensed to operate 1 card table and is requesting permission to add 19 more to its cardroom at its new location. Casino Fort Pierce has paid the \$19,000 license fee associated with the additional tables.

The Commission has received and reviewed the pertinent records and supporting documentation concerning Casino Fort Pierce’s amended application for a cardroom license and after proper consideration thereof,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it known that:

Pursuant to the requirements of section 849.086, Florida Statutes, the Commission hereby approves this amendment to Fronton Holdings, LLC d/b/a Casino Fort Pierce’s cardroom license.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO JUDICIAL REVIEW



THE NOTICE OF APPEAL MUST BE FILED WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS OF RENDITION OF THE ORDER TO BE REVIEWED.
